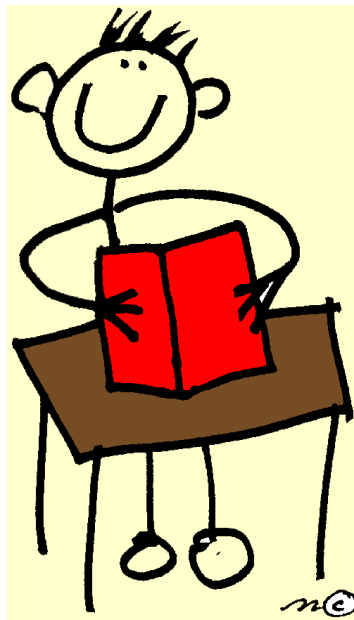

The Cape Harbour Marina is located at the mouth of the Caloosahatchee River in a sheltered harbor at ICW Marker #92 Latitude: 26° 32.73N Longitude: 82° 00.46W just 3 1/2 miles from the Gulf Mexico.

The dockmaster Frank has requested that once you have secured your boat in the marina that you go to the dockmaster office to register. All boats will dock along the sea wall at the end of the marina by the low rise buildings. This marina does not offer assistance with docking.
