The "Original" Baker Bash

Entry Requirements- This high school tournament is managed by Beaver-Vu Bowl in conjunction with joint sponsorship and supervision by Beavercreek & Xenia High Schools. This tournament will observe the rules and regulations of participation and play of the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA). Participation is open to any 2020-2021 school-sponsored bowling team. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD / DRINK MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE BOWLING CENTER.**

Due to facility considerations, the maximum number of teams is limited to sixty (60)* and will be determined based on the date the paid entry is received. First come-first serve. <u>Unpaid entries will NOT be accepted by telephone or E-mail</u>. Tournament management reserves the right to balance the boys & girls fields with an even number of teams in each gender division for lane assignment purposes. Spectator admission of \$6.00 will be charged. Children age 6 & under: N/C. Each team may admit a maximum of 8 uniformed bowlers* and two (2) coaches at no charge.

Tournament Format - There are four (4) separate team divisions: varsity boys, varsity girls, JV boys & JV girls. Five (5) participating bowlers per team. Team roster is limited to eight (8) bowlers*.

Qualifying Round: All teams will bowl twelve (12) Baker games. All ties for advancing teams will be broken by a 9th-10th frame roll-off. Qualifying Round lane assignments will be decided by the tournament manager.

<u>NOTE</u>: The scores from the Qualifying Round will only be used to determine the teams that advance to the Championship Round. The scores from the Qualifying Round do <u>not</u> carry over to the Championship Round.

<u>Championship Round:</u> Advancement: The top 50% of the participating boys varsity and girls varsity teams, based on Qualifying Round scores, will advance in their respective divisions to the Championship Round. The top 4 or 6 JV boys and JV girls teams (on site determination of the number of advancers depending on field size), will advance to the Championship Round in their respective divisions. Format: Each Championship Round will consist of an "eliminator" format consisting of two (2) Baker games. The top 50% of the teams in each division, based on their total two (2) game series score against the field will advance. This advancement format will continue until a winner is determined. (Example: 20 Championship Round varsity teams, reduced to 10 teams, reduced to 3 teams, 3 teams bowl in the Championship final.)

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the top two (2) teams in each division. Trophies will be awarded to the top varsity teams.

***SAFETY POLICIES - PLEASE READ**

This tournament entry form was prepared in August, 2020. The covid-19 safety policies as mandated by the OHSAA, The State of Ohio and the bowling center regarding maximum number of teams, maximum number of roster players, and maximum number of spectators allowed have yet to be determined for January, 2021. We will proceed for now assuming we will be allowed full 60 team participation & full spectator attendance. If restrictions that prohibit unlimited spectator, full roster, or 60 team attendance are in effect, we may be required to reduce the number of teams, number of roster bowlers, and the number of spectators allowed. If so, we will reduced team participation based on 1st come-1st serve receipt of paid entries and limit spectators as directed. Team Head Coaches will be notified of any participation/attendance restrictions via E-mail.
