Vineyard and Terroir

- Location: Châteauneuf-du-Pape, between Orange and Avignon.
- **Soil Type**: Rolled pebbles (galets roulés) on the surface, with sand, clay, and limestone deeper down. This combination allows the vines to grow deep roots, contributing to the complexity of the wine.
- **Viticulture Practices**: Organically farmed since the 1960s, with biodynamic practices employed to preserve the vineyard's natural balance.







Winemaking

- Harvest: Hand-harvested separately for each grape variety.
- Vinification: Reductive varieties like Mourvèdre and Syrah are fermented in oak fermenters, while other varieties are fermented in enameled concrete tanks. Once malolactic fermentation is complete, the different varieties are blended and aged in large oak foudres for one year before bottling.

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Tasting Notes

- Appearance: Deep, intense ruby-red color.
- Aroma: Rich and complex, with notes of spices, fresh fruit, cocoa, and brandy.
- Palate: Full-bodied, generous, and elegant, with a silky texture and powerful aromas of blackberries and noble spices.
- Finish: Long and refined with excellent balance and length.
- **Aging Potential**: Can be enjoyed now, but has the potential to age gracefully for 20 years or more.
