Carl L. Fry, 62 of Lake Township, passed away Saturday, Nov. 6 at his home, following a short illness.

He was born Oct. 19, 1931 in Stearnville, near Grand Rapids, son of the late Lloyd and Mary (Gillote) Fry. He was united in marriage to Dolores "Fudge" Colley on Oct. 25, 1952 in Winslow, WA.

Mr. Fry lived on the western side of the state until he joined the Navy in 1952. After his discharge in 1954, he settled in Garden City, where he became an iron worker instructor with Local 25. He later taught at Mott Community College, retiring in 1987 and moved to Lake Tep, permanently.

He was a member of St. Felix Catholic Church, Pinnabog, Casaville F.O.E., Iron Workers Local 25, Detroit and was an avid golfer. He was also a U.S. Navy Veteran, serving in Korea.

Mr. Fry is survived by his wife, Fudge; four sons, Michael (Yvonne) Fry of Lapeer, Patrick (Liz) Fry of Waman, Terry (Diane) Fry of Westland and Tim (Marilyn) Fry of Garden City; his daughter, Michale Fry of Westland; five grandchildren and one brother, Keith (Mary) Fry of Grand Rapids.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Homer Fry.
