Beginning on January 2nd, you may begin entering student evaluation info online on your teacher home page at MTAC.org. The deadline to enter repertoire is February 14th, (Valentines day). Please keep the following information in mind when choosing repertoire.

The length of the evaluation should be kept in mind when selecting and programming repertoire. Repeats are strongly discouraged for evaluation due to length. D.C. and D.S. al fine sections and first and second endings may be performed. Please check your instrument Syllabus.

For Convention performance in Festival Recital, Theme Recital, Ensemble or New Materials please refer to the time limits on the Convention Recital Program Guidelines 2014 located under documents on the teacher homepage.
