

HERBERT ALVIN HAWTHORNE

1922 - 1996

Herbert A. Hawthorne, 73 of Caseville, died Monday June 17 at Huron Memorial Hospital following a long illness.

He was born July 4, 1922 in Huntington, West Virginia, to the late Harry and Bertha (Richfield) Hawthorne.

On Aug. 26, 1942, he was united in marriage to Betty Barnes in Toledo, Ohio.

Mr. Hawthorne had been employed by the City of Allen Park water department for more than 35 years, retiring in 1976. They moved to Caseville that same year.

He was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Sand Point, Jean Post #543 American Legion, Caseville, and was a World War II veteran.
