

JACK MOUSE

Drummer Jack Mouse's extensive background began with three years as featured soloist with the U.S. Air Force Academy Falconaires. He has since performed with such notable artists as Stan Kenton, Clark Terry, Bunky Green, Joe Williams, James Moody and Randy Brecker.

His recordings as a leader include two CDs of original compositions, *Intimate Adversary* (2019) and *Range of Motion* (2012), as well as free improvisation, *Three Story Sandbox* (2016) and *Snakeheads & Ladybugs* (2014). He can also be heard on recordings by Janice Borla and the Dan Haerle Trio.

Mouse is Assistant Professor of Music and Coordinator of Jazz Studies at North Central College (Naperville IL) since 1996. He has also served on the faculties of the American Conservatory of Music, Benedictine University, Saskatchewan School of the Arts, Clark Terry Great Plains Jazz Camp, National Stage Band Camps, Jamey Aebersold Combo Camps and the Janice Borla Vocal Jazz Camp.

Presently he is a staff artist/clinician for Yamaha Drums, Sabian Cymbals, Vic Firth Sticks and Aquarian Drum Heads.
