## **CenterFire Pistol League – Winter 2025**

The Southport Winter Precision Pistol (aka Bullseye) league was January to April 2025 for 13 weeks. Course of Fire was one National Match Course with a .22 and one National Match Course with a centerfire pistol for a total of 60 shots. Fourteen (14) Shooters chose to shoot each phase with a .22 pistol. Fifteen (15) shooters shot the first stage with a .22 and the second stage with a choice of a centerfire pistol. Centerfire pistols used included: 9mm, .32, .38, or .45 caliber.

High highest score for each match in each stage is used to determine ranking and awards to recipients. For awards, the shooters were grouped by .22 only, and .22 & Centerfire. Individual ranking was made for each of the individual matches: 10 shots in slow fire (10 minutes), 10 shots in time fire (2 strings of 5 shots in 20 seconds), and 10 shots in rapid fire (2 strings of 5 shots in 10 seconds). Aggregate totals were made in each stage. Total League Aggregate Winners were:

Slow Fire – 2 -matches of 10 Shots in 10 minutes
Time Fire – 2 - matches comprised each of 2 strings of 5 shots in 20 seconds
Rapid Fire – 2 – matches comprised each of 2 strings of 5 shots in 10 seconds.
National Match Course
Slow Fire – 10 shots in 10 minutes
Time Fire – 2 strings of 5 shots in 20 seconds each
Rapid Fire – 2 strings of 5 shots in 10 seconds each

This weekly match format is the same as will be used at the NRA Precision Pistol Sectional which will be held in January 2026. Participation in the league will help prepare the individual shooter to participate in the NRA Sectional.
