training. Chief said the cost to train is free for FF1 and equal to 1 ISO point, FF2 costs\$1300 and 2 ISO points, and a paramedic costs up to \$6000 training. Currently we have 11 active EMS.

Matt Baird spoke of needing an ambulance when an employee had cut his arm. The wait was 30 minutes. Chief Sternburg stated during the day it is hard when everyone is at work. Trustee Toman commented our big weakness is manpower. Chief Sternburg stated 2 more paramedics and 3 more EMT's are needed. Mr. Sandstrom asked why Lane's cannot be in Ellsworth to cover during the days. Brian O'Neil said Lanes is in North Jackson and they have 9 cars on the road. Tom Powell stated when Pellin's went out of business, Lane's wanted \$120,000 per year volume out of a car, and now it is \$187,000, which won't happen. Matt Baird said he had 2 employees he would ask to consider EMT training to be available during the day. Matt Stroney suggested the fire department bill the homeowner's insurance for the calls, as they could receive up to \$500 per call. Lee Sandstrom stated the residents don't pay for the ambulance. Chief Sternburg said the residents are soft billed for the EMS. If the resident chooses not to pay, they are not billed again.

At 7:05 p.m. Trustee Spellman made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Trustee Toman. The vote was all in favor.
