Members present were, Mayor David Kater, Alderman J.D. Hodge, Alderman Alvin Sutton, Alderman Jerry Hulsey, Alderman Chris Gremminger, Alderman David Shaw, and Alderman Deion Christopher. Staff present was City Administrator Dan Bryan, City Clerk Stephanie Daffron.

There were no visitors.

City Administrator Dan Bryan presented the 2020-2021 fiscal budget to the board. Main items discussed were a 10% decrease in revenue along with no increase in health insurance; insurance will be budgeted using last year's amounts. Court fines were discussed since the city has not had court for the last couple of months due to COVID-19. Court Administrator Linda Simino felt confident she would make up the lost revenue by having multiple courts the month of June to make up for the loss. The Board discussed Chief Water Operator Paul Pilliard along with the water department. The board agreed to give Mr. Pilliard a raise of \$1,000.00 for the year. Randall Helms, Public Works employee, was approved for a raise, \$13.36 to \$15.30, as he will be advancing from a laborer to an operator. The board agreed not to approve raises for the rest of employees. The board approved capital expenditures with discussion between a mini excavator and a skid steer. The board agreed to approve capital request for the skid steer and trailer.

The adopted budget and amended budget shall be presented to the board in ordinance form Monday,
