

OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRANSFERS (previously known as Move-Ups)

After a dog earns its title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date has passed. This transfer may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has complete the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.

Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed.

The request for a transfer must be in writing or email and presented to the Trial Secretary or Superintendent at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.


Paradise Valley Park is located on west side of 40th Street between Bell Road and Union Hills Road in Phoenix, AZ.

From Tucson take I-10 to SR 51 north to Bell Road, exit east, turn north on 40th Street.

From Flagstaff take I-17 to the east 101, exit south on SR 51, exit east on Union Hills Road, turn south on 40th Street.

From the West take I-10 to the north 101, exit south on SR 51, exit east on Union Hills Road, turn south on 40th Street.

From the East take 101 to the north, exit south on SR 51, exit east on Union Hills Road, turn south on 40th Street.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

No entry can be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Telegraphed, emailed, telephoned, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms & no entry fee will be refunded in event of errors after closing date of entries.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms & photocopies without Agreements & Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. All entry forms must show the name of the Club and date of the trial.

Judging programs will be emailed to the email address given on the entry form. If not received within a reasonable time prior to show, notify the Trial Secretary. To receive the judging program electronically please provide your email address on the entry form.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Bench Show Committee or because dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. There is no refund of entry fees for duplicate entries.

Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in the trial that come into season after closing date of this show may be obtained by sending a veterinarians certificate to the trial secretary. The certificate must be postmarked before the opening day of the show or given to the Trial Secretary before the start of the show. A \$5.00 service fee will be deducted from the refund. All refunds will be mailed to the exhibitor after the show is over.

The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the trials.

Trophies are to be picked up at the trial on the day they are won. None will be mailed. Any not claimed become the property of Phoenix Field & Obedience Club.

All dogs must be on leash, or confined to a crate or exercise pen when they are not in the ring. No crating or exercise pens allowed within 20 feet of rings or on any of the walking areas. Flexi leashes are not allowed.

No dog should be at the Paradise Valley Park Small Event Field that is younger than 6 months old. Please plan to bring your own shade and Chairs. *WE DON'T PROVIDE OVERNIGHT SECURITY.*

Friday afternoon: Exhibitors may set up on the field AFTER all the PFOC rings and equipment are in place, sometime after 4:00 PM.

PFOC welcomes everyone's help to set up the rings and equipment on Friday Afternoon. Emergency number at the Trial site is (602) 999-1978. Dogs are not to be left unattended in hotel rooms unless crated. Hotel rules must be followed.

ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES (checks made out to PFOC) MUST BE IN THE OFFICE OF THE TRIAL SECRETARY NO LATER THAN 10:00 PM, MST, WEDNESDAY JANUARY 5, 2022, after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, or signed and no entry fees refunded. Telephoned, telegraphed, and emailed entries are not accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show rules.

THIS TRIAL is governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the back side of the entry blank in this Premium List.

Phoenix Field & Obedience Club may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or any other cause. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to amount of each returned check.

THE CLUB AND ITS TRIAL SECRETARY will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog or the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or other causes. it is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is in the care. custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog in on the Trial premises. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging of their class. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. There is no rule of this CLUB or the AKC that requires a Judge to wait for a dog.

Exhibitors are requested to maintain clean conditions around their vehicles, tents, exercise pens and crates. No exhibitor ring set-ups are allowed in the Paradise Valley Park Small Event Field. Do not leave any dog in closed vehicles. All persons attending these Trials hereby waive any claim for damages against PFOC or it's members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating of suffocation due to improper ventilation.

RECORDING & EVENT FEES: A Recording Fee of \$0.50, Event Services Fee of \$3.00 and a Rally Fee of \$3.50 will be required for Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience, or Tracking Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

AKC CODE OF SPORTSMANSHIP

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous com- petition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of pure- bred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
