

## Yamhill Fire Protection District receive grant

The Yamhill Fire Protection District received a grant from the Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution Fund in the amount of \$2,599.00. The grant funds were used to replace the District's aging CPR manikins and to purchase CPR compression training tools.

The Fire District provides CPR and First aid classes through, out the year at a cost of \$30.00 per student. The District's goal is to keep the cost down and get as many people trained as possible. The District currently trains between 125 to 200 people per year in CPR / First Aid.

Being in a rural area it takes a several minutes to get help. By having more people trained in the basic CPR / First Aid helps to provide for a more positive outcome and time for higher level EMS people to arrive.

This grant has provided the needed funds to continue providing these CPR / First Aid Classes at a low cost to the student, but also provided a more real-life experience when going through the training. With the compression tools, you can see if you are performing your compressions to slow, to fast, to deep, or not deep enough.

The Yamhill Fire Protection District has been very blessed by the Siletz Tribal Charitable Contribution Fund. This is the third time that they have assisted the District. The first grant a few years ago was for a Fit Testing machine that is needed to make sure, the self-contained breathing apparatus masks make a good seal to each firefighter. The second grant was for new Automatic External Defibrillators (AED's), and now the third for the CPR / First Aid Training materials. If it wasn't for the generosity of the Siletz Tribal Fund, the District would not be able to provide the community AED's, and CPR / First Aid Classes.
