

COME FLY AWAY

The new Broadway musical, *COME FLY AWAY*, conceived, choreographed/directed by Tony Award-winner Twyla Tharp and special arrangement with the Frank Sinatra Family and Frank Sinatra Enterprises, makes its Los Angeles premiere. Original vocals by Frank Sinatra, *COME FLY AWAY* Broadway stars and *Sinatra Dance With Me* cast (played at Wynn Las Vegas) combines classic/new vocals from Sinatra archives and signature arrangements by Nelson Riddle, Billy May and Quincy

Jones. The play follows four couples falling in and out of love during a song and dance filled evening in a club. An onstage big band with 14 incedible dancers. Classics, "Fly Me To The Moon," "My Way," and "That's Life," soar with romance and seduction.

COME FLY AWAY, premiered in September 2009 and opened on Broadway in March 2010. Twyla Tharp's creative relationship with the music of Frank Sinatra began in 1976 with the premiere of *Once More Frank*, a duet created for the American Ballet Theatre, performed by Ms. Tharp, Mikhail Baryshnikov and continued with Nine Sinatra Songs, Ms. Tharp's acclaimed piece for fourteen dancers, which had its world premiere with Twyla Tharp Dance in 1982, to be followed by *Sinatra Suite*, a duet featuring Mr. Baryshnikov and Elaine Kudo, premiering in 1984 with American Ballet Theatre at the Kennedy Center when Sinatra received his Kennedy Center Honors Award.

One of the most accomplished artists today, Twyla Tharpp has created groundbreaking work in ballet, on Broadway, in film/ television and authored three books. She has choreographed more than 135 dances, five Hollywood movies and directed and choreographed four Broadway shows. She received one Tony Award, two Emmy Awards, 19 honorary doctorates and a 2008 Kennedy Center Honor. Tharp founded/choreographs her own dance company and has created dances for the Joffrey Ballet, American Ballet Theatre, the Paris Opera Ballet, the Royal Ballet, New York City Ballet, Boston Ballet and others.


