2/3/16 meeting minutes were approved

Community Needs:

Library: they would like to stay where they are located now; however, create a small satellite area that is run by the library.

Historical Society – they would like to stay where they are located but create exhibit space to be set up near town office for displays.

Food Pantry – Current operation would remain at the East Baldwin Church. There is a need for storage for non-perishable items. The space NEEDS to be heated, shelves need to be 6 inches off the floor and the space needs to be locked.

Recreation – discussed aerobics/yoga classes, gym equipment, cooking/nutrition programs, summer rec programs for youth, extension programs during the school year, farmers market for local farmers, Agency on Aging coming in for specific trainings  
--It was also discussed that all recreational options could be completed in the meeting space/multi-purpose room

New Business – Larry Lord has discussed briefly with Cote & Howe in regards to the commercial needs. Paul Howe will be invited to attend a meeting to further explore these options.
