Amanda M. Bergman, 87, of Sebewaing passed away Wednesday, June 26, 2002, at her home following a lengthy illness. She was born Aug. 19, 1914 in Sebewaing to the late Oscar and Maria (Gall) Reinhold. She was baptized at Immanuel Lutheran Church on Sept. 13, 1914 and confirmed on April 1, 1928 by the Rev. L. List. Amanda was united in marriage to Hilbert Bergman on Aug. 21, 1954 at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sebewaing. He preceded her in death on Dec. 30, 1986. She was employed as a clerk at the U.S. Post Office in Sebewaing for more than 30 years.
