Transportation Laborer Position

The Craig Tribal Association is recruiting for the Transportation Laborer Position, this position performs any combination of duties on construction and general projects working on sidewalks, road reconstruction, bridges, culvert installation, water and sewer, etc. This position is seasonal, primarily on-site, in the field, and may involve work at multiple job sites during a workday.

The Transportation Laborer will be directly accountable to the Road Crew Lead and Transportation Department Manager, under the general supervision of the Tribal Administrator for the performance of assigned duties and responsibilities.

Qualifications:

- High School diploma or GED.
- Knowledge of road construction, culvert installation, and water line installation in a difficult and dangerous environment.
- Ability to understand and obey laws and regulations.
- Ability to perform tools and equipment maintenance and minor repairs.
- Knowledge of construction site surveying and control stakes.
- Ability to form and install rebar for concrete headwalls.
- Ability to work as a team member.

Physical requirements:

- Ability to work extended time outdoors.
- Position requires time spent in attics, crawl spaces and other enclosed areas.
- Must be comfortable and capable of working safely alone. Comply with OSHA industry standard safety limits are applicable.
- The ability to lift 50 pounds without difficulty is required.
