

To No Extent

To no extent should you focus on your troubles, because Jesus told you, "In this world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." (John 16:33).

The Word of God is your source for life. His Word is a certainty. Scripture teaches that victory belongs to you and is attainable in this life. It is not something that might be possible, it already belongs to you.

To no extent should you allow anything into your life that contradicts His Word. When you focus on things that are not of Him, you contradict His Word. When you contradict His word you put yourself in conflict with His Word.

You live with confidence that through God you overcome because He is perfect and His love drives out all failure. God doesn't only want to help you overcome the big obstacles in life, He wants to show you that He is there every single step of the way.

But Gina, you just don't understand how long this has been going on. Friend, I totally get it... however, to no extent should you focus on your weakness, because the Word says, the Lord is the strength of your life" (Psalm 27:1) and the people that know their God shall be strong and carry out great exploits (Daniel 11:32).

He loves you because you are His child, and He will take care of you if you let Him. Let His love and faithfulness guard your heart and life. Let your confidence be in Him because you know His eye is on you.

Walk in the confidence that He has given you the victory because no good thing does the Lord withhold from those who walk uprightly (Psalm 84:11).
