#### Picnic Tables

 Board decided to wait until the Fall to finish the picnic tables and purchase the material at that time.

### Ranch House

- A homeowner presented the board with a quote that he got for a 30'x16' metal building lean to for \$21,000. Slab price not included nor interior buildout
- Jim Holtzman showed the board members a design of a 20x40 wood frame building (approximately \$60K-\$65K – price includes slab, insulation, electrical, etc. Does not include installation cost. Construction possible done with volunteers from the neighborhood to reduce costs. Jim will fine tune costs.
- Kevin Hoover showed the board members a design that was approximately \$47K with a slab included in the price, with the company doing the installation. Price does not include interior build-out. Approximate cost with interior build out is \$62,000.
- Board will have the pricing and detail for the options so it can be presented to the community for their vote at the next meeting.

## • Tree by branch leaning

 Jim Richardson gave the board a price of \$900 to remove the leaning tree on Beachway Lane across from Chris Haddad's house. This price included dropping the tree only and grinding the stump. Dave Barksdale motioned to accept the \$900 for the removal. Anthony Noti seconded the motion. Motion carried.
