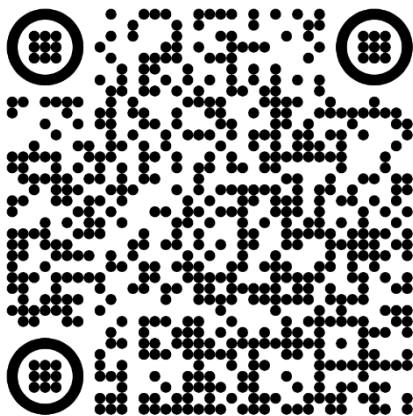


2026 District Conference

Servant Keeper Online Giving

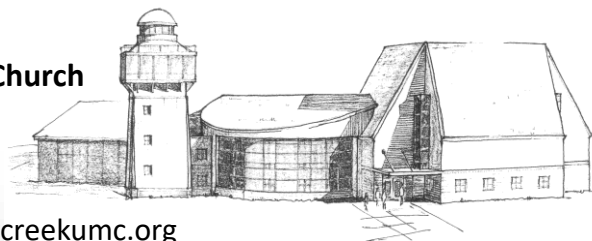
