


# **EVENTS THROUGHOUT THE WEEK**

HAVE A SAFE ENJOYABLE SUMMER!



The Charlotte County Sheriff's office has made the public aware that the 2020 Census data collection effort will begin August 4th through October 11, 2019. The Census Bureau temporary field staff will work in neighborhoods

across Florida to update address lists and maps using a laptop computer. Field staff will be

knocking on doors in order to verify addresses and gather information on additional living quarters, in an effort to accurately count the population.

If you are visited by someone from the Census Bureau, here are some ways to verify the individual is a Census Bureau employee. The field representative will present an ID badge that includes:

- their name,
- their photograph,
- a Department of Commerce watermark, and
- an expiration date.

\*\* Please note that the Census Bureau will never ask for your full social security number, bank account number, or passwords.\*\*

# RAIN AND


**THUNDERSTORMS**
