CHARTER MASTER'S REPORT

I would like to wish everyone a Happy Holiday, may your holiday be a blessed one with your family & friends.

We have completed our last charter for the club's past fishing year schedule. It was our 3.5 day combo charter in October. This was one of the best charters of the year. We departed with a full charter of 20 Anglers, one of them was an Active duty Marine. The first two days we fished in Mexico and we all limited out with Yellowfin Tuna also many of us limited out with Dorados as well. For day three we tried an area between San Clemente Island and the Cortez bank, our Captain was informed that some boats had found some Blue Fin in that area. We had no luck there, so we worked our way to the Cortez bank where we did our bottom fishing for the combo part. For day three everyone limited out with some Yellowfin, Rock fish and White fish. Many of our members used the descender to release many of their smaller Rock fish. As we started to head on home and dinner was served our Captain found some of the bigger Blue Fin Tuna. One of our guest Joseph Bariones was the first to land one, then he also landed his second one, followed with Dave Hagler landing the third one. There were about three more big ones that were lost as well. Day one jack-pot went to Andy Underwood with a 20-pound Yellowfin, day two went to Jim Mauritz with a 17-pound Dorado and day three went to Joseph Bariones with a 100 pound Blue Fin. This was our only charter aboard the Poseidon this year, Captain Hunter and his crew did an outstanding job. They were very friendly and helpful to our members and guest.

We have started our next year's schedule with a Rock Cod charter in December which is full. I have also secured a contract for January, this will be a 2-day charter heading to the Colonet area. This charter will be departing on Tuesday January 15th at 6:00 PM aboard the Relentless out of H&M, we will return on Thursday the 17th somewhere between 6PM – 8PM, return time depends on if we find any Yellow Tail on day two. This charter is limited to 16 Anglers with a cost of \$438 all meals and the fishing visa are included. You must have a Passport for this charter. If you want on this 2 day charter please give me a call at 760-450-7060.

Our full 2019 charter schedule calendar will be presented at our January Club meeting.

Don't forget, if you are interested in being considered to be selected as a Charter Master this coming year, you must complete the Charter Master Training Course this year and complete Marshall Goddard's CPR & AED course. Both courses require pre-sign ups, so please make sure that you **contact me and Marshall before the December Club meeting**. These courses will follow our regular club meeting on Tuesday December 4th. First is the Charter Master course then the CPR & AED course.
