• Recovered over \$19M in unnecessary expenditures

While leading and managing the procurement workload in support of the entire USAF basic research mission, I implemented a pre-inspection of procurement operations and discovered that some of our strategic partnerships were no longer completely realizing the benefits of competition. I planned a more effective path forward, brought together a team to analyze disparate spend and organize procurement by like services/supplies, and then coordinated both an external audit of relative historical costs and internal work schedules to accommodate several time zones. As a result, my team recovered over \$19M in unnecessary cost reimbursable contract expenditures and gained information needed to avoid future monetary loss through optimization of our long term procurement relationships.

- Avoided \$10M in costs and saved 10% (\$40M over five years) and earned promotion While serving in the Pentagon with a mission to provide operational procurement support across DoD organizations, I planned, organized, and led a strategic sourcing effort culminating in the cost avoidance associated with the loss of IT services (estimated at \$10M) to over 10,500 end-users located throughout the National capital Region (NCR). Subsequently, competition was enhanced to allow an acquisition strategy savings of 10% (\$40M over five years) and I earned an internal promotion to oversee acquisition support to Headquarters Department of the Army, Operations and Plans; the largest headquarters section in the U.S. Army.
 - Repaired 7 bridges, improved 22 miles of road network and oversaw / provided logistics to a 600+ person organization in a remote jungle environment

While serving as the commander of a US Army Construction Company, I led 200+ personnel to deploy \$40M+ in heavy construction equipment from a US location to the Nicaraguan Jungle, set up a base camp, and executed humanitarian aid construction in support of the Hurricane Mitch relief efforts; my team repaired 7 bridges and improved 22 miles of road network. Additionally my company oversaw/provided logistics to a 600+ person heavy Construction Battalion in a remote jungle environment that included but was not limited to medical operations, aerial resupply of critical supplies, minor maintenance and major repair for over \$200M in additional construction equipment, mobile food service, potable water delivery, over the road fuel and supply distribution, controlled sensitive item accountability, etc.
