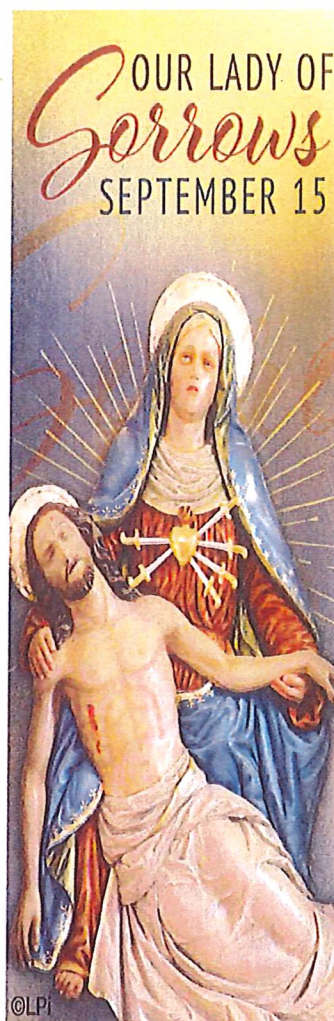

Rest in the presence of God simply because God is God and you are you. This is all that is necessary. 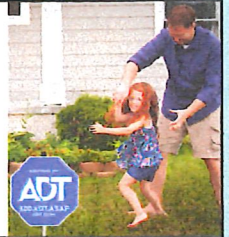
