IASMC Midwinter Meeting Minutes Saturday, March 10, 2018 Greenville, South Carolina

Meeting opened by President Mike McLaughlin at 9:00am and Welcoming Comments Made.

Opening prayer – led by David Wright / Shrine pledge of allegiance – led by Dennis Green

Reports - Sergeant at Arms – Jorge Rocha - Total number of officers present 7; Total number of non-officer meeting participants present 13; Number of past presidents present 6; Other than past presidents and current officers, number of temple represented 13; Total number of votes present in the meeting 17; Number required for simple majority 7; Number required for 2/3 majority 13

Secretary / Treasurer's – Jay Alfirevic- dues -115 in so far; Cakras Ads due by 4/15; **ByLaws Updates** - as published on www.iasmc.org- adoption motioned and passed unanimous (seebelow); **Competition Rules Updates** - as published on www.iasmc.org - motioned and passed unanimous (see below)- **PLEASE REVIEW - Most important items: New 4/Multi Wheel Obstacle Course Layout and Requirement to Display IASMC Silver Wings Pins on Uniform.** Banquet - \$40 per person - Sloppy Joe's. Use online website to register and pay - to be set up by Assistant Sec/Treasurer with Assistance from Lester Szkodzinski, Medinah; financial report - current balance \$16,051.71 last year was \$14,439.40 at same date. IRS990N to be filed prior to May. **3rd Vice President's report – David Wright** - ride / walk track oppy extended to 3pm

2nd Vice President's report – Rand Seppelin - Discussion of New 4/Multiwheel O Course

1st Vice President's report – Ed Raper -taking current timers for service / Central States - field size of 120x240 & number at CSASMC banquet (700+) discussed

President Elect's report – Dennis Green - introductions of officers & divan from other associations. Demonstration of new timers by Cahaba - Approx \$550-750ea / 9volt batteries last 8 hours. Costs vary with accessories. Track - Same layout, wrist bands etc as last year - will work to improve access and reduce backlog. Nashville 2019 - plans in progress. Meetings June 29. Competition June 30 at Titans Stadium - walking across bridge to Broadway Entertainment District. Field a little short though. Banquet Monday July 1st at Al Menah Temple. Music City Sheraton is probable hotel. Temple for trailer parking & will be secured. 6 miles from hotel to downtown. Mid winter in St Augustine, FL - date TBA in March 2019.

President's report – Mike McLaughlin Meeting Saturday, Competition Sunday, Banquet Monday night - Most likely Sloppy Joes. Rules changes intended to make it more fun & make sure people have a good time. Evolutionary & concerns for increasing participation & membership. Discussion/ promotion of Las Vegas Shriner Golf Outing & Mike being scorekeeper for Bubba Watson.

OLD BUSINESS - Proposal for new 4 wheel obstacle course. Need to be proactive New layout discussed. Ride in reverse direction on alternate years. Fast & easy to layout course - 30-35 minutes total. 1 minute run on a trike & a drifter in testing. 10 ft wide lines vs previous 9 ft. Motioned & passed. Proposal and considerations for payment/additional attempt at 2 wheel (and 4 wheel) obstacle course & slow race - Need to determine the fee (decision – no fee); What is the decision point – when the man is in the finish box; If a 2nd run is taken, the time from that run is the only time considered; Ken Maynard emphasized importance of communication yes/no; Howard emphasized that teams do have the opportunity to walk the course./ motioned & passed. Proposal to require IASMC metal wings for Imperial competition. Motioned & passed. Also discussed - importance of recognizing the need and option to reduce the size of the competition field & obstacle course as needed by space available.

NEW BUSINESS Candidate for Sergeant at Arms- Lester Szkodzinski - Medinah - presented his qualifications and Masonic Resume - motioned and proposed for election on July 14th and endorsed by Officers / Board. In 2019 Luke Baker - Past Potentate Morocco and FASMC Officer declared he intends to submit his name for Sergeant at Arms once President Elect Dennis Green completes his term, in consideration that 2 officers may not be from same Temple. Candidate for Secretary / Treasurer - CJ Apel (Zenobia) has been functioning as appointed Assistant Secretary Treasurer for 2017/2018. At the 2018 General Meeting on July 14 his name will be submitted and endorsed by the Officers to the membership to be elected as the new Secretary Treasurer succeeding our current Secretary/Treasurer Jay Alfirevic for a minimum 3 year term. As of mid winter meeting there are no other suggestions for candidates for this office. Any other nominations must submit their qualifications in writing at least 30 days prior to the general meeting to be considered. Difficulty in finding 150 x 300 sized fields

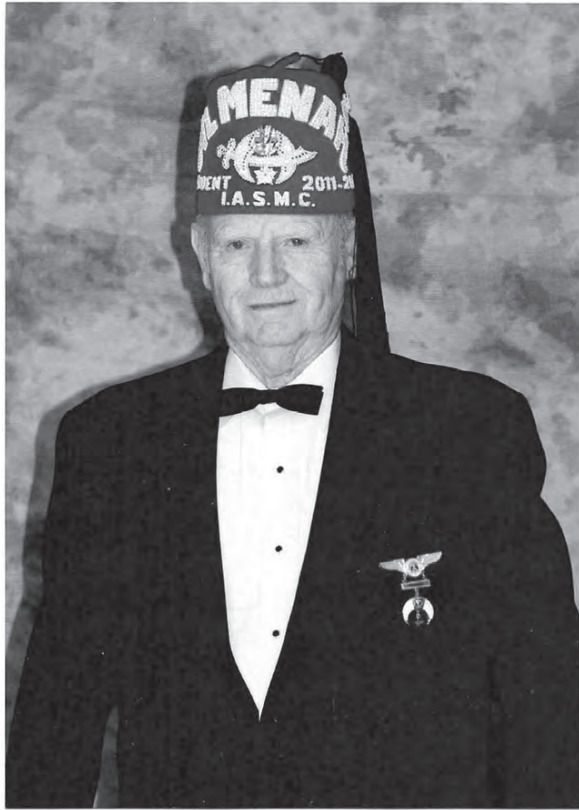

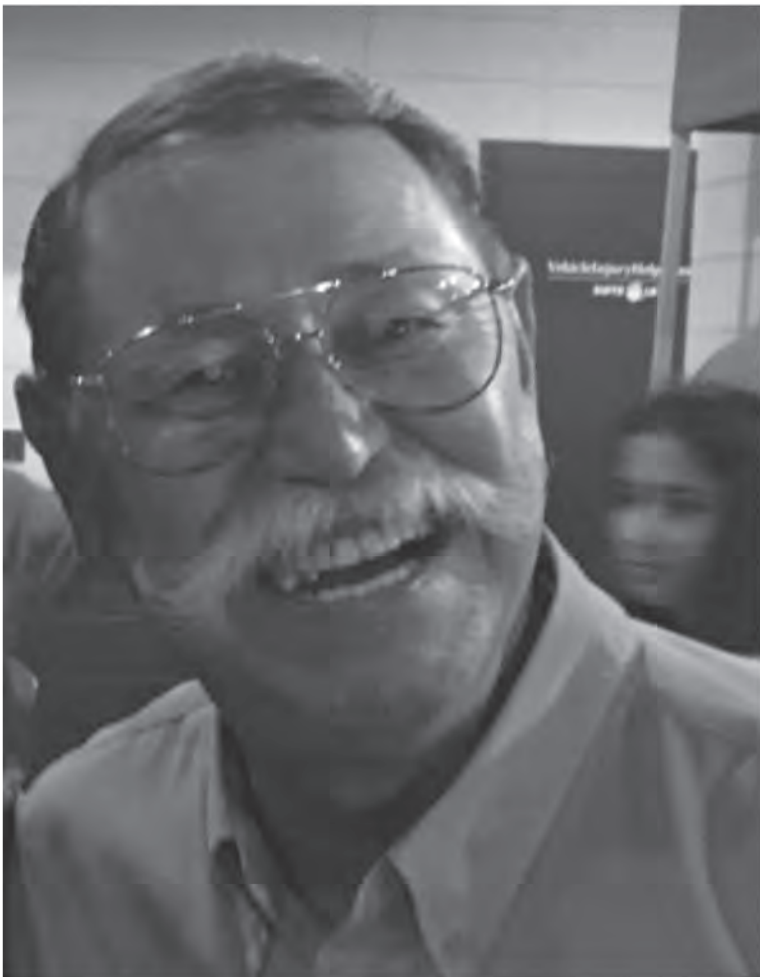
