

SUPPLIES FOR ALTERNATIVE TOOLS FOR WATERCOLOR

PAINT

Lemon Yellow, Permanent Rose, Winsor Blue (or Thalo Blue)

Ultramarine Blue, Indian Yellow, Raw Sienna or Gold Ochre, Burnt Sienna

Dioxanine Violet (or Winsor Violet), Daniel Smith Sap Green

BRUSHES: 1" Wash, #8 Round, Liner

PAPER: 3 sheets of 140# Arches Cold Press, 11" x 14"

Heavy duty plastic wrap

Pebeo masking fluid

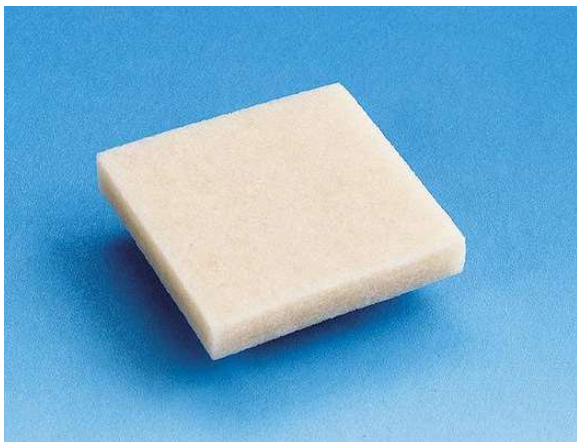
3M tan painters masking tape

A credit card you can cut

Table Salt

Dish soap, mixed $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ with water. (You will need about a tablespoon of this, just enough to wet your brushes.)

Resist Remover (This is an Alvin Pik-Up Rubber Cement Remover)



Pencil and kneaded eraser



Utility knife

Scissors

Saral Graphite transfer paper, or you can use a window. This is for transferring the drawing onto your watercolor paper.
