NvFRW Encourages Voter Identification Legislation

Las Vegas, NV — April 28, 2016 — Board members attending the Nevada Federation of Republican Women's 2016 Spring Board Meeting in Las Vegas, Nevada voted unanimously to encourage the 2017 Nevada Assembly and Senate to pass legislation which "thoughtfully, prudently and reasonably" requires government-issued voter identification that is readily accessible to all voters.

"One vote, one citizen. That is what our elections are based on," said Lori Piotrowski, president of the Nevada Federation of Republican Women. "Participation in the electoral process is one of our most basic and precious rights as U.S. citizens, and because of this, it is important to ensure that every citizen's vote counts. Elections may be won by a handful of votes, which further emphasizes the importance of honesty and integrity in the voting procedure."
