Steven Donahue, 69, died from brain stem tumor complications on Friday, June 14, 2013.

He was born July 28, 1944, in Harbor Beach. He and his wife lived in Port Hope and Harbor Beach from 1973-1979, when he owned a photography business called Steven's Studio.

This kind gentle man with a wonderfully wry sense of humor was a consummate artist/photographer for more than 45 years and taught many people the art of the darkroom and studio. He was the proprietor of Central Photographic in Albuquerque, New Mexico since the 1980s. He loved blues music and walking in nature.

He is survived by Paula, his loving wife of 42 years; sister, Andrea Walker (Scott); brother, James Donahue (his wife, now the late, Doris); sister-in-law, Rosella Stern (Freddie Walker); and many loving nieces, nephews, friends and extended family.

Steven was preceded in death by his parents, Edwin and Velma Donahue.
