## **COVID-19 Guidelines**

The safety of our students, families, and faculty is our primary concern as we move into lessons for the upcoming academic year. Please take a moment to read carefully through our safety guidelines. For the well-being of all, we will be strictly adhering to all safety policies outlined below.

- Students will be required to wash their hands upon arrival or use the sanitizer stations located in the waiting room.

- If a student tests positive for Covid-19, they should plan to attend lessons virtually. A student should only return to in-person study after testing negative or completing the required isolation period of 5 days with an improvement in symptoms and no presence of fever for 24 hours. We ask that students plan to wear a mask to lessons for a full 10 days after diagnosis.
- Music 101 will continue to monitor and adhere to all state and federal guidelines regarding Covid-19. Music 101 reserves the right to change COVID requirements based on the most up to date information. Families and students will always be notified of any changes as soon as they are available.
