AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE, TRANSFER, AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC AND FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Each application for a retail liquor license store license, liquor-licensed drug store license, beer and wine license, hotel and restaurant license, tavern license, club license, racetrack license, arts license, and fermented malt beverage license filed with the Town of Marble, Colorado, shall be accompanied by an application fee to cover actual and necessary expenses in the following amounts:

1. New liquor license application fee: \$450.00
2. Transfer of ownership license fee: \$250.00
3. Transfer of location liquor license fee: 250.00
4. Renewal of liquor license fee: \$50.00
5. Arts or special events liquor license fee : \$25.00 per day.

SECTION 2. Said application fees shall be paid into the treasure of the Town of Marble and are in addition to other fees required by law, and are to defray the expense incurred for publishing and posting notices, investigation, and hearings upon applications.


