FOOD IS ALWAYS NEEDED

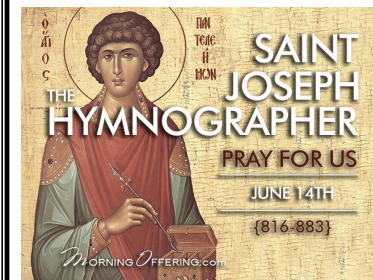
A can of tomatoes, some macaroni, maybe some cookies? Voila! A meal! Please remember those who

ST. JOSEPH THE HYMNOGRAPHER Feast Day June 14

In light of the current restrictions against congregational singing we can give a thought to Saint Joseph the

Hymnographer, the most prolific of the Greek hymn writers. A native of Sicily, he was forced to leave his island in 830 AD in the wake of an invasion by the Arabs, journeying to Thessalonica and then to Constantinople. During this time he was captured by pirates and sold into slavery in Crete. In slavery St. Nicholas appeared to Joseph and asked him to sing in the name of God. Nicholas then said to him: "Arise and follow me!" Joseph found freedom soon after his vision. Joseph's career straddled both the Eastern and Western churches and he appears in Latin as well as in Greek hagiography. St. Joseph went on to establish a monastery and is noted for his confession of faith in opposition to the Iconoclasm current at that time in this case the destruction of venerable icons. He was among those who inspired the first missionaries to Russia. He reportedly possessed the "gift of discernment" for which Photius, the ecumenical patriarch of Constantinople appointed him the spiritual father and confessor for priests, recommending him as, "A man of God, an angel in the flesh and father of fathers." He is regarded as one of the greatest liturgical poets and hymnographers writing 385 canons and 9 kontakia of the menaion, 68 canons of the parakletike, 6 complete canons of the triodion and 34 triodes-tetraodes, 2 canons and 24 triodes-tetraodes of the pentekostarion and most likely as the author or even inventor of the Parakletike, which contains proper office hymns for each weekday.
