I am once again excited to announce our impending move to St. John Neumann for the 2020–2021 school year. As we move into this exciting time for both our students, staff and parents, I would like to thank you for choosing St. Anne School for your child’s education. Every child at St. Anne School is celebrated for their God given unique gifts and talents. With the many financial demands placed upon families I appreciate what a sacrifice a Catholic education can be. Our goal, as always, is to keep tuition as affordable as possible and at the same time offer our students the quality education that defines who we are at St. Anne School.

Again, this year I would like to challenge our parents to spread the word about all the exciting programs at St. Anne School. You are our best advertising media.

This year we have an exciting offer for all families. Any current or new St. Anne School family who returns the completed registration forms and fees by March 2, 2020 will be entered in a raffle. Forms and fees would include:

- **Registration or re-registration form**
- **Registration fee and activity fee**
- **Tuition agreement form**
- **Tuition assistance form (if requesting assistance)**
- **Parish verification form (Catholic families only) - form must be signed by Pastor**

The raffle will award one lucky family a tuition credit of \$2020.00 for the 2020-2021 school year! This credit may be used for your family or donated for a family in need.

Tuition for the 2020-2021 school year has been set. With the help of parish subsidies, scrip sales, Neumann Scholarship and fundraising efforts, St. Anne School strives to keep tuition at an affordable rate while continuing to provide a quality Catholic Education to our families. The cost to educate a student at St. Anne School is approximately \$7700.00. Our new tuition rates listed below provide a substantial discount to every family. In addition to this discount, St. Anne School has a number of scholarship programs that can provide additional tuition assistance for our families that need it. Below are the new 2020-2021 tuition rates:

**Registration Fee - (Pre-K – Grade 8) \$100.00 per family for all families that register by March 2, 2020. The discount period ends on March 2 and the registration fee will increase to \$125.00.
Student Activity Fee - (K-8) \$70.00 per child.**

In addition to the tuition schedule above we ask every family with children in grades Pre-K to grade 8 to purchase \$350.00 per/month for ten months for a total of \$3500.00 in scrip gift cards. In addition to the convenience the cards offer, St. Anne School uses the funds generated by the program to:

- Keep tuition rates down and affordable
- Generate funds for the Guardian Angel Tuition Assistance Program

Families with students in grades K-8 are asked to perform 40 hours of service to the school. Clearances are needed to volunteer.

Both the Scrip Program and the Service Volunteer program have a buy-out option available.

St. Anne School has Neumann Scholarship, (SPE) EITC and Guardian Angel Scholarship monies available for our students. All families seeking any of these tuition assistance (TA) programs must fill out the FACTS online grant and aid form. Failure to do so makes a family ineligible for any type of assistance. Paper forms are not available. Online forms can be accessed through our website on the homepage under the Parent drop down. All applications must be submitted by March 1, 2020. Please contact me with any questions.

The criteria for tuition assistance will be as follows:

- Annual income
- Number of students in tuition paying schools
- Actively involved with parish and school

Reminder:

Tuition payment cycle will begin in July, 2020 and end in April, 2021.
