

ORDINANCE NO. 2013- 5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN CODE BY ADDING ATTORNEY FEES AND COSTS TO DOG OWNER ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the Town council of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana (the "Town Council") has determined that the costs associated with the enforcement of regulations of unrestrained animals should be allocated to the violators of Animal Control Ordinances.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED

That the town code should be modified by adding the following provisions.

Section § 6-14 (e)

Reasonable attorney fees and associated costs

Section § 6-25 (b)

For any case that requires litigation or the involvement of an attorney on behalf of the town, a reasonable attorney fee and associated costs shall be assessed against the violator.

This ordinance supersedes and replaces any rule regulation or ordinance that conflicts with its provisions.

This ordinance is effective as of the date of passage and publication as required by law.
