OH, HOW HE LOVES ME!

Oh, how he loves me, Oh, how he loves me: I know not why, I only cry, "Oh, how he loves me."

Do you know? Are you keenly aware? Can you even imagine? ...the depths of God's love for you? This old hymn by Johnson Oatman, Jr., 1899 and Henry Lake Gilmour only begins to scratch the surface of that love! During this Lenten season, we continue to study and discuss the depts of that love which God has for each of us.

During a recent confirmation class, we discussed Matthew 27:26 *So he released Barabbas for them, and after flogging Jesus he handed him over to be crucified.* We studied what the one word "flog" meant and what actually happened BEFORE they turned Jesus over to be "crucified." We read the words flogged and crucified without realizing what those two words means. What does this physically mean for the earthly body of Jesus? It means they literally beat Jesus unto within an inch of his life. It means that even after that, they then nailed him to a heavy wood cross bar so that he would be in the visible presence of everyone – and that he would then DIE! Why? For you and for me!

It's so easy to gather on Palm Sunday, wave our palm branches and sing Hosanna! We can gather on Maundy Thursday, have our feet (or hands) washed, celebrate Holy Communion (in the night when he was betrayed), and then gather on Good Friday to be reminded of his death.

The tomb was sealed because it was filled with Jesus, the Messiah! Filled and sealed and a guard posted there because the authorities were afraid someone would take the body. The tomb was filled with our Lord; the flogged and crucified Son of God!

Jesus went to the cross for the sins of all humanity. He did not go for the people alive and sinning while Jesus was on the earth. He came for those who lived before him, during his life, and for us, those who are alive and working for the kingdom of God today!

He was flogged and crucified, filled and sealed, but God is not finished! God is still the One! God raised Jesus from the dead! God didn't raise Jesus and allow him to walk on earth again for himself. Again, God did this miracle for you and for me. Jesus is alive and we are to serve him with our heart, our soul, and mind! Let's enter into this Holy Week on Palm Sunday, continue the journey, and celebrate on Easter knowing the depts of God's love for us!

OUTREACH TEAM HAPPENINGS






