Paul H. Moore, 59 of Elkton and formerly of Bad Axe and Lansing, passed away Friday, Dec. 15 at his home following an apparent heart attack.

He was born on June 16, 1936 in Plattsburgh, NY, son of the late L. Harry and Irene (Crotz) Moore. He was united in marriage to Sylvia (Roland) Stager on Nov. 17, 1961 in Africa.
