

AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO

Ordinance: O-2013-57

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council of Amelia Village desires to continue waste collection services be provided to the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village will be accepting sealed bids for waste collection services within the corporate boundaries of the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained, by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio; that:

SECTION I: This Council finds that it will be in the best interest of Amelia Village, Ohio to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the solid waste collection contract.

SECTION II: Council authorizes and directs the Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the collection of solid waste within the corporate boundaries of Amelia Village.

SECTION III: Under the bid specifications, each household will be billed, at the accepted bid price, on a quarterly basis for waste collection services, including waste materials and recycling.

SECTION IV: Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION V: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order to continue, without interruption, waste collection services within the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

DERRICK CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.


