

Copyright Compliance

Sherrard Public Library District supports the following provisions concerning copyright restrictions as stated in Title 17 of the United States Code:

The copyright law of the United States governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted materials. Under certain conditions specified in the law, libraries and archives are authorized to furnish a photocopy or other reproduction. One of these specified conditions is that the photocopy or reproduction is not to be “used for any purpose other than the private study, scholarship, or research.” If a user makes a request for, or later uses, a photocopy or reproduction for purposes in excess of “fair use”, that user may be liable for copyright infringement.

The Sherrard Public Library District reserves the right to refuse to accept a copying order if, in its judgment, fulfillment of the order would involve violation of copyright law.
