



My 1956 Buckskin Tan TBird

I joined NJORTC in 1998 right after I purchased my 1957 Dusk Rose Bird. I found out that it was a Senior Gold Concours car. Although I took some "ribbing" about it being an Italian macho guy driving a "pink" TBird, I still loved the car. and the unique color. In 2008 I had to sell it due to a divorce.

For the next four years I kept the memories, awards and the pictures close to me.

In the summer of 2013, I decided it was time to look for another Dusk Rose 57, so the search began. After answering numerous ads and coming up empty I decided I was open to other colors. In October Julia and I went to Florida, stopping on the way to look at a red 57 - it drove like a Mack truck. While in Florida I located two nice possibilities in South Carolina and made arrangement to look at them. Both sold before we could get there - UGH!!

At this point I was getting a little discouraged to say the least. Back home, I saw an ad in CTCI's classifieds for a 56 Buckskin Tan for sale in Wisconsin. But I wanted a 57? HMMM, Buckskin Tan is a very rare color - but not Dusk Rose? After thinking it over and doing some negotiating the 56 Bird was on its way to NJ. The owner told me that the color of the car was a shade off from Buckskin Tan. The pictures he sent me did not reveal the true color.

The day before Thanksgiving, on a cold rainy night, the car was delivered. The driver pulled the car off the truck in the dark and pulled it into my garage. WHOA! - to my surprise the Buckskin Tan had a beautiful shade of Rose tint to it under the lights. I was pleasantly surprised with the color and the TBird was actually in better condition than described by the seller.

Last summer we entered the TBird into the Concours D' Elegance at Ramapo College. Julia told me she wanted to get a color matching outfit, so I gave he my credit card with confidence she would never be able to match the color and my card would be safe. Foolish assumption. After an extensive Willowbrook search a matching outfit was found and purchased. I should have known better? All's well that ends well, we received a 2nd place behind Charlie Costa's beautiful Peacock Blue 56.




