## **Trip Packing List**

**Bring your gear in a duffle bag**

**WHAT TO BRING (bring/wear appropriate items to the trip, based on the weather):**

- **Full Class A uniform with long pants and Troop Neckerchief**
- **Winter sleeping bag or sleeping bag w/blanket or sleeping bag liner**
- Sleeping pad
- Water Bottle, filled
- Contractor-grade trash bag to line duffle bag
- *Small* flashlight or headlamp (new batteries)
- Weather-appropriate gloves; hat with visor; knit hat
- Small bottle of sunscreen; small tube of lip balm
- Change of pants, shirt, and underwear (jeans are heavy and bad when wet. Avoid sweatpants, which are bulky and heavy) – bring synthetics if you have them.
- Long underwear
- Jacket
- Synthetic pullover or Troop Jacket
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Rain jacket; rain pants (if you have rain pants. Don't buy them just for this trip)
- WEAR sturdy hiking boots
- PACK sneakers to wear as camp shoes
- Wool or synthetic hiking socks – wear 1 pair pack 2 pair
- Troop mug (or equivalent)
- Spending money
