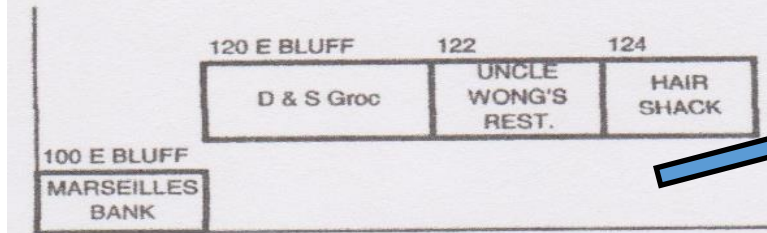

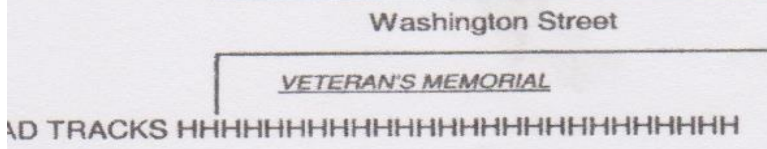
531 Main: (South Section) 1901 Smith & Tummel Barber Shop, Charles Smith & Frank Tummel

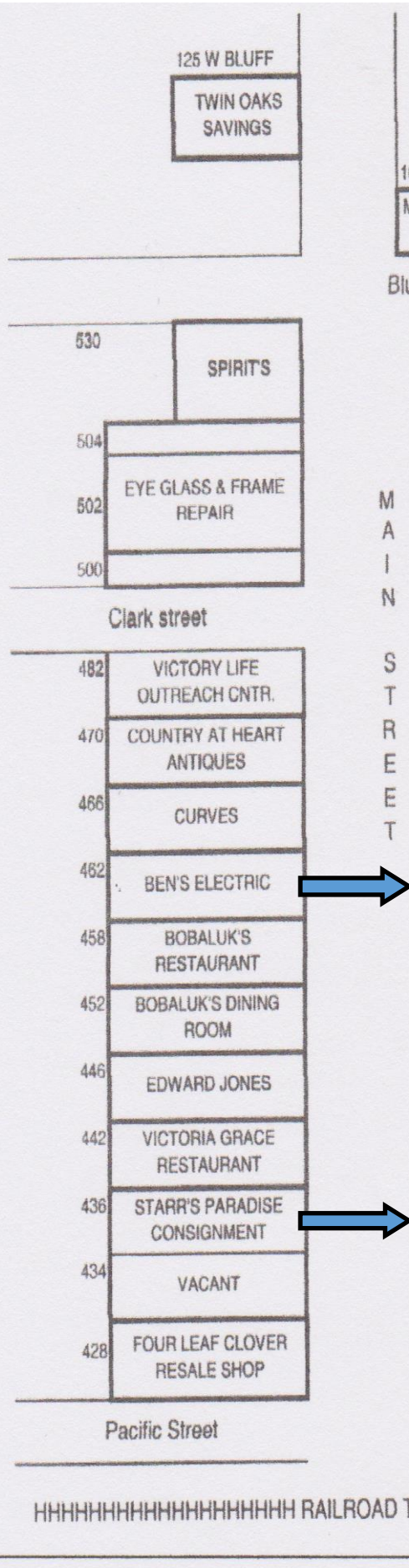
527 Main: 1899 used as a Barbershop in a wood frame bldg. Was moved to Washington Street in later 1899. Brick bldg. as barbershop in : 1933-1935 Thomas Barber Shop, Bob Thomas

483 Main: Wood frame bldg. built before 1889 housed mostly barbershops. Bldg was replaced about 1905.
1896: Thomas Lyle & Herbert Goddard
1898: Tummel & Charles Smith

469 Main: 1907 was a barbershop, 1917-1930 First Class Barber Shop or Smith & Son, Charles Smith & Al Smith
1930 Smith & Bullock Barber Shop, Charles Smith & Cliff Bullock
1930-1931 Al "N' Cliff's Barber Shop, Al Smith & Cliff Bullock
1931: Smith Barber Shop, Al Smith
457 & 469 Upstairs: 1896-1898 Tummel & Smith Barbers

453 Main(Second Floor South 445 Main): 1880's - 1892
Watterich Barber Shop, Charles Watterich; 1900 - 1935 Watterich Barbershop, Charles Watterich & John Danish
1935 -1946 Danish Barber Shop, John Danish
Bottom Floor: 1913-1917 was a Pool Hall & Barbershop, Charles Smith, barber



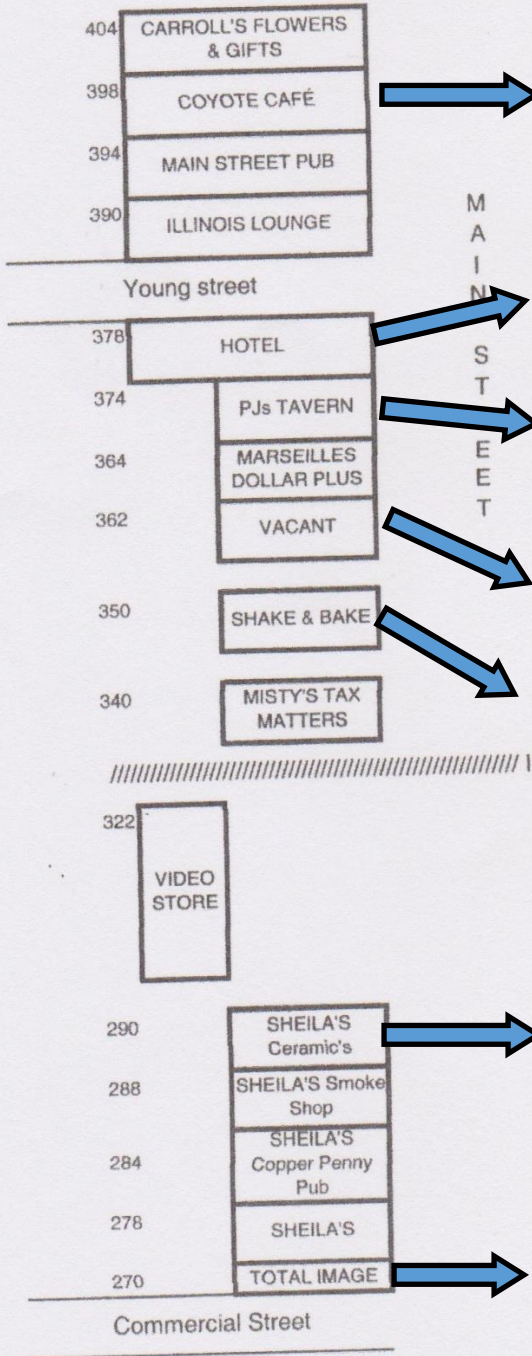

374 Main: 1935 Sineni & Boetto Barber Shop, Mike Sineni & James "Speed" Boetto
1937-1943 Sineni Barber Shop, Mike Sineni, Barber

362 Main: 1907 Barbershop

350 Main: 1942-1974 Reese's Barber Shop, Reese Allen
1942-1948 James "Speed" Boetto barbered in Reese's shop

290 Main: Small Store Front: 1973-1972 Allie Q's Barber Shop, Allen Querciagrossa, Barber

270 Main or Boetto Building: from 1888 until 1907, James M. Howard had a carpenter shop on this site. Then expanded by owner in 1923 to a small office behind a bakery. 1948 became the Unity Café.
1948-1972 Speed's Barber Shop, James "Speed" Boetto, barber
1972-1973 Allie Q's Barber Shop
