

### American Airlines to Offer Same Day Flight Change and Standby Via Smartphone App

American Airlines announced the release of version 5.4 of its smartphone app, adding several new features including the ability to make a same-day flight change via the app.

The app supports the feature for passengers traveling by themselves who have elite status with the airline, are flying in first class, or are traveling on a Y fare. The feature is accessible by tapping the desired trip and ac-

cessing the travel tools menu.

The airline also updated the user interface in this release for check-in functionality for international flights. In July, the Fort Worth-based airline added a new set of features to the app called Customer Baggage Notification. The new functionality notifies passengers shortly after landing via the app, text or e-mail message, of any irregular activity with their bags.

American Airlines to add 5 more destinations to Chicago lineup

American Airlines will add five more cities to its list of destinations from Chicago's O'Hare International Airport, including Canada's Vancouver and Calgary. Other new destinations are South Carolina's Charleston and Myrtle Beach; and Bangor, Maine.

TSA says old driver's licenses OK for air travel until 2020

Transportation Security Administration spokesman Mike England announced that driver's licenses from all 50 states will be acceptable identification for domestic US air travel until Oct. 1, 2020. Airport signs had previously warned that licenses from some states would no longer be acceptable as of Jan. 22, 2018. American Airlines, Southwest employees to get tax bill bonus

Reuters) - U.S. airlines American Airlines Group Inc AAL.O and Southwest Airlines Co LUV.N said on Tuesday that they would give their employees a \$1,000 bonus in light of the recent U.S. tax bill.

The airlines join a host of other companies such as AT&T T.N, Boeing Co BA.N and Wells Fargo & Co WFC.N promising to pay bonuses or invest more in training after the biggest overhaul of the U.S. tax code in 30 years, which cuts the corporate tax rate.

American Airlines will distribute the bonus to each team member, excluding officers, at its mainline and wholly owned regional carriers, according to an internal memo seen by Reuters. The distributions will total approximately \$130 million and will be made in the first quarter of 2018, the company said.

Southwest said in a statement that as well as paying the bonus to all employees in January, it was increasing its fleet investment with Boeing BA.N and had donated \$5 million to charitable causes.

The new legislation would "result in meaningful corporate income tax reform for the transportation sector in general, and for Southwest Airlines, in particular," said Southwest's Chief Executive Officer Gary Kelly.U.S. President Donald Trump signed the massive tax overhaul into law in December. It cuts the corporate tax rate to 21 percent from 35 percent.
