

# **RICHARD CASPER "CAP" LOTT**

## **1907 - 1996**

Richard C. "Cap" Lott, 89, of Holt, who served 33 years with the MSU Extension Service, died Friday, April 26.

He was born in Delhi Township, Holt, on April 19, 1907, the son of Frank C. and Susan (Bullen) Lott. He graduated from Lansing Central High School in 1925, and received his BS Degree in Poultry Science from Michigan State College in 1929 and his MS Degree in Agriculture Extension from MSU in 1956.

He was a vocational agriculture teacher for a number of years and began his Extension Service career in 1936, which included Huron County Extension Agent, program consultant, 1959-1962, and additional years as Extension, community research agent for Huron, Bay, St. Clair, Tuscola and Lapeer Counties, and other counties. He retired in 1968 after 33 years' service.

Mr. Lott was active in MSU Alumni Association, Alpha Gamma Rho fraternity, Lansing Farmers Club and First Presbyterian Church of Holt. He was awarded many honors for Extension and agriculture service, including the Distinguished Service Award from the National County Agricultural Agents' Association.

He was married to Katharine Adell Scott of Tuscola Nov. 27, 1931, and she survives him. He also leaves three daughters, four grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, one sister and brother-in-law and cousins, nephews and nieces.

He was preceded in death by a son, Roger Clinton Lott in 1961, a son-in-law and two sisters.

The funeral service was conducted in First Presbyterian Church, Holt, Tuesday afternoon, April 30. Interment was in Maple Ridge Cemetery.
