





#### Table 1. The Evolution of PESC APPROVED STANDARDS by Technology

As the community adopts a new technology, PESC develops and produces a corresponding PESC APPROVED STANDARD in that technology. Data contained in a PESC APPROVED STANDARD in one technology is equal to in ANS value and integrity to the same PESC APPROVED STANDARD in a different technology. For example, one organization using the PESC APPROVED College Transcript in EDI can trust another organization using the PESC APPROVED College Transcript in XML as development and production (through mapping) EDI use the same definitions, taxonomies and code sets.


