**Meeting officially started at 6:08**

**Coaches Report** – Mrs. Desiano spoke about the upcoming competitions and what is expected of the dancers. Dancers need to stay for entire competition until released by coaches. Dancers are not allowed to leave the competition for any reason this applies to leaving with a parent as well. Dancers are responsible for their own transportation to and from each competition.

Makeup for competitions was also discussed, girls have been told what to wear. Eyelashes and earrings must be worn to all performances and competitions.

On February 1<sup>st</sup> there will be a bus to take the dancers to their performance in Temple City. The girls will be leaving the school around 1:30 and arriving back at ANHS around 10:30. Any parents who would like to ride the bus and attend are welcome to do so but you will need to go online and purchase your ticket for the performance before. The bus will be stopping to get a quick dinner at some point in the evening so make sure the girls have money with them.

For USA Nationals in March the girls will be dancing on Sunday the 17<sup>th</sup> and unless we make finals which will be on Monday the 18<sup>th</sup>, Ann-Marie cannot ask to have all girls excused from school on Monday.

**President's Report** – Traci spoke about the upcoming USA Competition we are hosting on February 9<sup>th</sup>. Girls staying the night in a hotel need to remember that they must stay with the team during competition until released by the coaches. Also there will be no chaperones so it is the responsibility of the parents to chaperone their own girls.
