# Brandeis Happenings

#### Why do certain foods smell good to us?

Your mouth helps you smell tasty foods. New research by senses expert Don Katz shows that what happens in our mouths while we eat causes us to like the smells of certain foods. It turns out that we don't inhale the scent of food and decide we like its smell. First, we have to eat it.

Katz's research appeared in the January 7 edition of the journal Current Biology.




