Schedule:

- Any participants arriving in Ventura on **Tuesday, November 5**, can have dinner with the trip leader at a local restaurant at **6:30 PM**.

- Meet at Island Packers at **8 AM**, 1691 Spinnaker Drive #105B, Ventura, CA 93001, Tuesday, November 5 to meet the group and receive boat ticket.

- The boat will depart for Santa Cruz Island, Scorpion Cove at 9 AM.

- The group will spend the day on the island and board for the return trip to Island Packers in Ventura at **4PM**.

- Arrive at Island Packers and the mainland at approximately **5 PM**.

- If any wish to have dinner, the tour leader will accompany them to **dinner** at a restaurant near Island Packers.

Additional information:

Santa Cruz is the largest of the islands in Channel Island National Park. There are scenic hiking trails, colorful tide pools, and a variety of plants and animals. It will be possible to photograph both the endemic (seen nowhere else on earth) Santa Cruz Island Fox and Island Scrub Jay during the visit. Marine animals can often be seen during transit to and from the mainland.

The island is exceptionally rich in cultural history and remnants of the ranching era can also been seen and photographed on your visit.

Participants need to have **breakfast** before arriving at Island Packers at 8AM and need to bring **easy to carry items to eat during the day**, e.g., nutritional bars, fruit, nuts, etc.

Potable **water** is available in the campground area. Participants need to bring water and/or a refillable water bottle.

Picnic tables are in the Visitor Center area. There will be a **planned stop for "lunch"** when appropriate during the day.

Vault style **restrooms** are located near the beach and there are two restrooms in the campground. Island Packers **website** for Santa Cruz Island: https://islandpackers.com/santa-cruz-island/
