The Karrick Family would like to express our deepest thanks for the love and support Saint Olaf has shown us through this difficult time with our daughter Emily and her health struggles.

After many misdiagnoses we have discovered she has a chronic autoimmune disease in which the bile ducts in her liver are slowly destroyed. All of this has progressed to complete cirrhosis of her liver. Her medical team is currently working to stabilize Emily by attempting to slow down the progression of the disease in hopes she might qualify for a liver transplant in the near future. Our family, especially Emily, are humbled and grateful for the prayers and support.
