PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

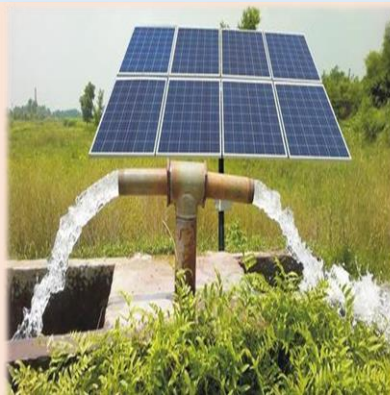
- ☐ Assist SDA, veteran, and beginning producers in owning and operating successful agribusinesses and improve their in USDA programs and services
