Behind the Battleground States

U.S. Presidential elections are sprawling affairs, with mail-in voting that begins weeks ahead of Election Day on Nov. 5 and in-person voting that begins at midnight that Tuesday in the small New Hampshire town of Dixville Notch and continues until voting ends at 7 p.m. in the Hawaiian-Aleutian time zone, already the next day back east. But in the U.S. system, that popular vote doesn't determine the outcome.

Each state gets a certain number of votes based on its size in what is called the Electoral College. Those votes are awarded on a state-by-state basis, and in all but two states - Maine and Nebraska - the winner takes all. Because many states vote dependably for Democrats or Republicans in presidential elections, the outcome usually rests on a handful of places where the election is truly competitive – the battlegrounds.

This year seven states are regarded as the battlegrounds. They include old-line manufacturing powerhouses that have had a tough transition to the 21st century economy, and fast growing southern states that used to be dependably Republican but are becoming more diverse. All seven have experienced demographic changes that may play into the outcome.

The battlegrounds have changed over time as the country's economic and demographic trends have shifted populations around. Florida and Ohio, for example, had been tightly contested in past elections, but now lean Republican in presidential votes. On the other hand shifting demographics have put southern states like North Carolina and Georgia into play for Democrats.

US voters press Congress candidates to fix housing crisis

From suburban New York to rural Montana, candidates for U.S. Congress are getting an earful from voters stressed by stratospheric housing costs, interviews with Democratic and Republican campaigns and Reuters/Ipsos polling showed.

At campaign stops in his New York state district, Democratic U.S. Representative Pat Ryan said in an interview that people regularly complain about having trouble finding a house or apartment they can afford. He is seeking to hold his seat, one of a couple dozen tight races his party must win in the Nov. 5 elections if it is to capture a majority in the House of Representatives.

"I would say right now ... in the whole region — the Hudson Valley north of New York City — the No. 1 point of economic pain and pressure is housing affordability," said Ryan, who wants money from

Democratic President Joe Biden's \$1 trillion infrastructure law to aid housing construction.

A Reuters/Ipsos opinion poll in May found voters rated the scarcity and cost of housing as their second-most important economic worry, after fears of stagnating income and rising prices.

Economic concerns are also central to the contest between Biden and Republican challenger Donald Trump. The winner's ability to enact his agenda will hinge partly on who controls Congress. Home prices nationally have risen about 50% in the last five years, with rent increases not far behind at 35%, according to real estate service firm Zillow. In Kingston, New York, about 100 miles (160 km) north of New York City and partly in Ryan's district, home values are up by 75% while rents have risen 58% in that period.







ISNA Convention in Dallas

The city's Anatole Convention Center is hosting the event, attended by about 20,000 Muslim community members.

On the first day of the convention on Friday, ISNA's central president and other officials held a joint press conference, announcing that more than 150 prominent speakers have been invited to address the convention.

In addition to roundtable discussions and interfaith receptions, other activities have also been organized. The ISNA Bazaar has been set up with



over 350 booths. The convention includes recreational activities such as sports and entertainment programs, with performances by singers and Qawwali sessions.

After the Friday prayers on the first day, the inaugural ceremony was attended by multiple officials and different faith members and community leaders.

ISNA, the largest representative organization of Muslims in the region, organizes the convention in different states across the United States every year. The convention in Dallas marks the first such event in ISNA's 61-year history.

It is the largest gathering of Muslims in the United States, which is attended by individuals from other faiths, international leaders, and senior federal government officials.

Additionally, the convention will address issues faced by the Muslim community in North America and apply pressure on American officials to resolve international issues affecting Muslims, including Palestine, Jammu & Kashmir, and Sudan, among other countries.

In his opening address, Zarzour stated that the convention is an excellent platform for people of different religions within society.

He emphasized that this is not just an event for Muslims but an event for all of America.

"It serves as an excellent mean of representation for individuals from various faiths, their families, businesses, and volunteer organizations," he said.

Dr. Basheer Ahmed's Speech at ISNA

Muslim Americans for Human Rights organized a seminar at 61st Annual Convention of ISNA on September 1. 2024 in Dallas, TX.

In a brilliant speech at a recent ISNA convention in Dallas, Dr. Basheer Ahmed conveyed that the Blasphemy Laws in some countries are going too far. In the speech, he emphasized; The Correct Way to Deal with Blasphemy Dr. M. Basheer Ahmed highlights a critical issue: anti-blasphemy laws, often intended to protect religious sentiments, can paradoxically incite greater hostility and violence. Instead of maintaining social harmony, these laws frequently become tools for personal vendettas and societal discord, as public sentiments override judicial processes.

As of 2014, 26% of the world's countries still enforced anti-blasphemy laws, according to a Pew Research Center report. In some countries, including Pakistan and India, these laws trace back to the British colonial era, where they were initially designed to curb communal tensions. However, their misuse has transformed them into mechanisms of oppression, stifling freedom of expression and fueling communal violence. A glaring example is the case of Junaid Hafeez, a Pakistani academic who was accused of blasphemy in 2013. Despite maintaining his innocence, Hafeez was sentenced to death and placed in solitary confinement, demonstrating how such laws can unjustly ruin lives.

The Quran and the teachings of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) offer a different perspective on dealing with blasphemy. The Quran advises believers to exercise patience and ignore those who mock or ridicule religion. For instance, Surah Al-Muzzammil (73:10) states, "Have patience with what they say, and leave them with noble dignity." Such verses emphasize restraint over retribution, underscoring that ultimate judgment lies with God alone.

The Prophet's life further illustrates this approach. When an old woman who regularly insulted him fell ill, he visited her, showing compassion rather than anger. He also forgave Suhail bin Amr, who had blasphemed against him during the Battle of Badr, and rejected calls to execute Abd Allah b. Ubayy, a known hypocrite. These examples highlight the Prophet's commitment to forgiveness, demonstrating that responding to blasphemy with kindness rather than violence aligns more closely with Islamic teachings.

Historically, some Muslim scholars have justified harsh punishments for blasphemy based on their interpretations of religious texts. However, contemporary scholars like Mohammad Hashim Kamali and Taha Jaber Al-Alwani argue that such rulings are not eternal norms but rather reflections of specific historical contexts. They point out that early scholars feared that

apostates could join enemy ranks and pose a direct threat to Muslim communities. In today's context, where there are 1.8 billion Muslims



worldwide and established freedoms of speech and religion, such fears are largely unfounded. Examples of how anti-blasphemy laws incite violence are plentiful. The extrajudicial killing of university student Mashal Khan in 2017 by a mob in Pakistan, Asia Bibi's wrongful death sentence in 2010, and the assassination of prominent human rights lawyer Rashid Rehman all reveal the dangerous consequences of these laws. Public anger often supersedes legal judgment, resulting in violence that contradicts both Quranic principles and Prophetic teachings. Ultimately, the correct response to blasphemy is not punishment or retribution but patience and education. Blasphemy laws do not protect religion; instead, they perpetuate cycles of violence and injustice. The Quran and the Prophet Muhammad's example teach us to respond to provocations with dignity and mercy, reminding us that true strength lies in restraint and compassion. It is time to reevaluate the application of these laws and align our responses with the authentic values of Islam.







It was no ordinary meeting of Georgia's oncestaid election board.

The state panel gathered on Monday for its second all-day meeting to discuss new election rules, hurling accusations at one another while its nonpartisan chairman banged his mallet, calling for order.

The five members had gathered to discuss last week's 3-2 vote to approve a rule that requires counties to hand count ballots on and after election night.

In recent months, the panel's new Republican members have approved changes that have sparked warnings this pivotal battleground state could once again find itself at the centre of confusion on and after Election Day.

After narrowly losing Georgia in 2020, Donald Trump and his allies filed lawsuits and spread unfounded allegations of election fraud, with Trump at one point pressuring Georgia's Republican Secretary of State Brad Raffensperger to "find 11,780 votes" - the margin he lost by in the Peach State.

Trump is currently fighting state criminal charges of conspiring to overturn that defeat in Georgia.

Since then, the drama has continued to play out at the state election board level, with Democratic member Sarah Tindall Ghazal accusing her Republican colleagues of being motivated by "far right-wing beliefs".

Sowing seeds of doubt

Last Friday's vote on the hand counting of ballots in Georgia came after weeks of objection from local election officials.

Poll supervisors in Georgia told the BBC the new rule could cause problems on and after Election Day, including delays in results reporting and human errors.

The new measure requires poll workers to hand count ballots on election night - or in some cases, the day after - to confirm that the number of paper ballots matches the amount tabulated by the machine.

Janelle King, a Republican who voted in favour of the rule, told the BBC the measure aims to ensure the accuracy of election results.

She noted that the rule does not require poll workers to count the actual results on the ballots, only the amount of papers.

"Our voters - I think they care more about accuracy than speed," she said. "It's the best practice."

Other election officials disagreed.

"It's a recipe for disaster," Anne Dover, a Republican elections director in Georgia's Cherokee County, told the BBC.

Dover says the new election rules are being pushed by those who fear the 2020 election was fraudulent. She says

her own husband has questioned the results of the election four years ago in other parts of the state.

"They're just not in touch with how hard elections officials work to do a good job," she said.

Ethan Compton, an elections supervisor in Irwin County, Georgia, says the new rule will slow down results reporting and "leave room for chaos, and chaos can sow seeds of doubt".

Compton worries that the aftermath of the election in Georgia in 2024 could mirror the events of four years ago, when Trump and his allies cited hours of absentee-ballot counting as evidence of voter fraud, undermining public confidence in the election process.

This isn't the first change of voting rules to spark uproar in an election year. Democrats triggered lawsuits four years ago after they broadened use of ballot drop boxes in Wisconsin and expanded postal voting in Pennsylvania.

But the difference in Georgia is that criticism is coming from both sides of the political aisle.

Georgia's State Election Board comprises three Republicans, one Democrat and a chairman appointed by the Republican governor.

The role was historically procedural and non-partisan, but in the aftermath of the 2020 election, the panels have emerged as a political lightning rod.

"Now, the job has turned into something that's like partisan football," said Gowri Ramachandran, director of elections and security at the Brennan Center for Justice, a liberal non-profit.

The state board was previously chaired by Georgia's secretary of state, but Raffensperger's fellow Republicans pushed him out after the 2020 election, a move critics say was revenge for his defence of the election results.

Since then, several Trump-aligned Republicans



have joined and won a majority on the board: Ms King, Ms Johnston and former Republican state senator Rick Jeffares.

During meetings, the board's three new Republican members have advocated for a number of changes to the state's elections, including a rule passed earlier this year that allows local election boards to conduct "reasonable inquiries" into election results before certifying them.

Ms King argues the rule will lead to "an increase in certifications" because board members can examine documents themselves.

"We want to make sure they have as much confidence in that election as possible," she said. Trump has personally thanked Ms King and her two newly appointed Republican board members by name, saying at a rally in Atlanta in August that the trio were "pit bulls fighting for honesty, transparency and victory".

Officials and election administration experts said that although the state board's rule changes could bring disruption in November, they believed Georgia's broader voting laws would ultimately pave the way for a secure presidential election.

Some also said they remained concerned about the damage that could be done to the public's trust in the election system.

Dover said the misinformation that circulated during the last election led to bomb threats and voicemails harassing election officials.

Peter Simmons, a Georgia policy strategist with the non-profit Protect Democracy, which describes itself as nonpartisan, noted that even though Trump's allegations of widespread fraud in 2020 have never been substantiated, a large portion of Americans still believe his claims.

"That's essentially what has inspired this set of actions [in Georgia] today," Mr Simmons said. Madeline Halpert BBC News

The three judges he appointed to the Supreme Court while president were pivotal in over-turning the constitutional right to an abortion, a 1973 ruling known as Roe v Wade. Immigration

Harris was tasked with tackling the root causes of the southern border crisis and helped raise billions of dollars of private money to make regional investments aimed at stemming the flow north.

Record numbers of people crossed from Mexico at the end of 2023 but the numbers have fallen since. In this campaign, she has toughened her stance and emphasised her experience as a prosecutor in California taking on human traffickers.

Trump has vowed to seal the border by completing the construction of a wall and increasing enforcement. But he urged Republicans to ditch a hardline, cross-party border bill, backed by Harris.

He has also promised the biggest mass deportation of undocumented migrants in US history. Experts told the BBC this would face legal

challenges.

Taxes

Harris wants to raise taxes on big businesses and Americans making \$400,000 (£305,000) a year.

But she has also unveiled a number of measures that would ease the tax burden on families, including an expansion of child tax credits.

Trump proposes a number of tax cuts worth trillions, including an extension of his 2017 cuts which mostly helped the wealthy. He says he will pay for them through higher growth and tariffs on imports.

Analysts say both tax plans will add to the ballooning deficit, but Trump's by more.

Harris has vowed to support Ukraine "for as long as it takes". She has pledged, if elected, to ensure the US and not China wins "the competition for the 21st Century".

Trump has an isolationist foreign policy and wants the US to disentangle itself from conflicts elsewhere in the world.

He has said he would end the war in Ukraine in 24 hours through a negotiated settlement with Russia, a move that Democrats say would embolden Vladimir Putin.

Trump has positioned himself as a staunch supporter of Israel but said little on how he would end the war in Gaza.

Trade

Harris has criticised Trump's sweeping plan to put tariffs on imports, calling it a national tax on working families which will cost each household \$4,000 a year. She is expected to have a more targeted approach to taxing imports.

Trump has made tariffs a central pledge in this campaign. He has proposed new 10-20% tariffs on most foreign goods, and much higher ones on those from China.

Climate

Harris, as vice-president, helped pass the



Inflation Reduction Act, which has funnelled hundreds of billions of dollars to renewable energy, and electric vehicle tax credit and rebate programmes.

But she has dropped her opposition to fracking, a technique for recovering gas and oil opposed by environmentalists.

Trump, while in the White House, rolled back hundreds of environmental protections, including limits on carbon dioxide emissions from power plants and vehicles.

In this campaign he has vowed to expand Arctic drilling and attacked electric cars. Healthcare

Harris has been part of a White House administration which has reduced prescription drug costs and capped insulin prices at \$35.

Trump has said he will not renew his attempts while president to dismantle the Affordable Care Act, which extended insurance to millions more people.

He has called for taxpayer-funded fertility treatment, but that could be opposed by Republicans in Congress.

Crime

Harris has tried to contrast her experience as a prosecutor with the fact Trump has been convicted of a crime.

Trump has vowed to demolish drugs cartels, crush gang violence and rebuild Democratic-run cities that he says are overrun with crime.

SLOW DOWN

BE DEFENSIVE & OFFENSIVE

Practice safe driving techniques related to defensive driving and Smith System 5 Keys. By using these tools, drivers can remain vigilant in their efforts to arrive safely.

USE SAFE DRIVING TOOLS

Drive with lights on and use warning devices to effectively communicate with other drivers. When pavement is wet, you should decrease speed, turn off cruise control, and increase following distance.

SEEK COVER

With a threat of excessive wind gusts, hail, or even tornadoes, limit driving to an as needed basis. Secure loads, protect vehicles and equipment, and seek shelter when severe weather is near.

HIGH WATER ON THE ROAD & AVOIDING HAZARDS

BE PREPARED

VERIFY CONDITIONS

In high water operations, it is important to remain aware of locations that may become impacted by flooding. All employees should be briefed and updated regularly regarding this information.

ENSURE ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES

Equip vehicles with necessary supplies to respond to flooded roadways. This includes PPE, signage, tools, and water/snacks, especially if employees will be stationed for long hours at these locations.

PLAN FOR MORE

Flooding creates hazardous conditions for workers. Verify that first aid kits are stocked, and fire extinguishers are charged before response.

SLOW DOWN

TURN AROUND

When roadways are covered in water, turn around and never attempt to drive through. It may be worse than what it initially appears. Vehicles are not equipped to handle high water, which may cause the engine to flood or be carried away.

BE CAUTIOUS

In the event of rain or wet pavement. drive carefully to the current conditions to avoid loss of traction on the roadway. Operators should turn off cruise control, slow down, and increase following distance.

HAVE A WAY TO ESCAPE

Avoid areas that would require backing. If backing becomes necessary, use a spotter, when available. Perform 360 walkaround to confirm surroundings are free of hazards.

STAY FOCUSED

OBSERVE SURROUNDINGS

Identify unsafe travel paths and avoid driving through these areas. Debris, fixed objects, downed powerlines, or other items may be hidden. If you don't know, don't go!

CALL A TIME-OUT

When faced with situations that may become unsafe, workers should utilize stop work authority and communicate hazards with others. When conditions improve, a new plan of action may be taken.

REMAIN ALERT

Long hours in this type of emergency response may affect workers ability to remain vigilant. It is essential to communicate with supervision about this to ensure operational readiness.

Hoda Kotb Decided to Exit 'Today' After NBC Proposed Cut to Her \$20 Million Salary | Report

Hoda Kotb's surprise announcement this week that she will be stepping down as anchor of NBC's "Today" was in part due to the network asking her to take a pay cut, Puck News reported

According to Puck, she earned more than \$20 million a year, a salary network executives told her couldn't be justified anymore thanks to the changing broadcast landscape.

"NBC executives loved Hoda and knew her value to the brand, but also made clear to her agents that such stratospheric contracts were no longer justifiable given the industry's inexorable decline," due in part to the steep ratings decline affecting "Today" and competitors like "Good Morning America," Puck reported.

In September, 2014, averaged 4.672 million total viewers. However this month, the show averaged 2.536 million, despite narrowly beating rivals at other networks.

Representatives for NBC didn't immediately respond to a request for comment from TheWrap.

Kotb announced during episode that she will step down and transition into a as-yet unspecified different role at NBC early in 2025.

In a memo to staff that Kotb also read on-air, she said that made her decision in August after realizing "it was time for me to turn the page at 60, and to try something new."

"As I write this, my heart is all over the map,"
Kotb continued. "I know I'm making the right
decision, but it's a painful one. And you all are
the reason why. They say two things can be
right at the same time, and I'm feeling that so
deeply right now. I love you and it's time for me
to leave the show."

Kotb has spent 10 of her 26 years at NBC at "Dateline," . She helped launch the show's



fourth hour alongside Kathie Lee Gifford and Jenna Bush Hager.

Why JPMorgan Chase is prepared to sue the U.S. government over Zelle scams

Buried in a roughly 200-page quarterly filing from JPMorgan Chase last month were eight words that underscore how contentious the bank's relationship with the government has become.

The lender disclosed that the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau could punish JPMorgan for its role in Zelle, the giant peer-to-peer digital payments network. The bank is accused of failing to kick criminal accounts off its platform and failing to compensate some scam victims, according to people who declined to be identified speaking about an ongoing investigation. In response, JPMorgan issued a thinly veiled threat: "The firm is evaluating next steps, including litigation."

The prospect of a bank suing its regulator would've been unheard of in an earlier era, according to policy experts, mostly because corporations used to fear provoking their overseers. That was especially the case for the American banking industry, which needed hundreds of billions of dollars in taxpayer bailouts to survive after irresponsible lending and trading activities caused the 2008 financial crisis, those experts say.

But a combination of factors in the intervening years has created an environment where banks and their regulators have never been farther apart.

Trade groups say that in the aftermath of the

financial crisis, banks became easy targets for populist attacks from Democrat-led regulatory agencies. Those on the side of regulators point out that banks and their lobbyists increasingly lean on courts in Republican-dominated districts to fend off reform and protect billions of dollars in fees at the expense of consumers.

"If you go back 15 or 20 years, the view was it's not particularly smart to antagonize your regulator, that litigating all this stuff is just kicking the hornet's nest," said Tobin Marcus, head of U.S. policy at Wolfe Research.

"The disparity between how ambitious [President Joe] Biden's regulators have been and how conservative the courts are, at least a subset of the courts, is historically wide," Marcus said. "That's created so many opportunities for successful industry litigation against regulatory proposals."

Assault on fees

Those forces collided this year, which started out as one of the most consequential for bank regulation since the post-2008 reforms that curbed Wall Street risk-taking, introduced annual stress



tests and created the industry's lead antagonist, the CFPB.

In the final months of the Biden administration, efforts from a half-dozen government agencies were meant to slash fees on credit card late payments, debit transactions and overdrafts. The industry's biggest threat was the Basel Endgame, a sweeping proposal to force big banks to hold tens of billions of dollars more in capital for activities like trading and lending. Ingredients

⅓ cup neutral oil

1 bay leaf

1 black cardamom

4 cloves

½ inch cinnamon stick

1 large yellow onion thinly sliced in half rings

1 tablespoon ginger and garlic paste

2 to 4 bird's eye chilies or to taste sliced lengthwise

½ teaspoon turmeric powder

1 teaspoon cumin powder

2 teaspoon coriander powder

1 teaspoon red chili powder

1 pound ground beef

1 1/4 teaspoon salt or to taste

1 cup full-fat yogurt whisked and brought to room temperature

Instructions

Heat oil in a heavy bottom pot. Once it begins to shimmer, add whole spices (bay leaf, black cardamom, cloves and cinnamon stick) and fry on medium to medium-low

The Kashmiri politician whose return from jail ruffled feathers

As Indian-administered Kashmir prepared for assembly elections earlier this month, a local MP returned home from a Delhi prison to campaign for his candidates. Who is he and why does his return matter to the region's politics? Auqib Javeed reports from Srinagar.

Sheikh Abdul Rashid, who had been in jail since Article 370 was abrogated in 2019, was granted interim bail earlier this month on terror funding charges he denies.

The 57-year-old, who is popularly known as Engineer Rashid, has urged people to vote for his candidates instead of regional or national parties. His Awami Ittehad Party has fielded candidates in more than three dozen seats.

The high-stakes assembly elections are the first since the region's autonomy was revoked in 2019. With 873 candidates across 90 constituencies in the Muslim-majority Kashmir valley and Hindu-majority Jammu, the elections have been described by federal officials as a proof of normalcy in a region long plagued by insurgency. The third and last phase of the polls will be held on Tuesday and votes will be counted on 8 October.

Kashmir's politics, dominated by mainstream parties pledging allegiance to India, has had a history of individuals and groups seeking separation from the country or enhanced autonomy for Kashmir, with some of them supporting an armed movement to achieve that.

Some separatist groups in the past have also backed Pakistan's role in Kashmir. India and Pakistan both claim Kashmir in full, but control only parts of it.

But this assembly election has seen participation of many former separatist leaders as well.

Rashid has chosen to be part of the democratic process but has been vocal against what he calls Delhi's "heavy-handed" rule in Kashmir.

He is known for his fiery speeches, and leading protests in unconventional ways against alleged government excesses, often irking authorities.

He made waves in June when he defeated regional political heavyweight Omar Abdullah in parliamentary elections. While he was lodged in jail, his sons led an emotionally charged and successful campaign on his behalf.

But this time he is able to speak to voters directly and he has also smartly used social media to amplify his messages.

Within hours of being released on 11 September, Rashid told the media that he was going to fight against the removal of Article 370.

The article allowed the state its own constitution, a separate flag and freedom to make laws. Foreign affairs, defence and communications remained the preserve of the federal government.

"We don't accept Prime Minister [Narendra Modi's] decision taken on 5 August [2019]," he said, referring to the day when the autonomy was abrogated.

He then went live on Facebook, repeating similar messages. The hour-long speech currently has more than 2.5m views, 44,000 likes and 25,000 comments – an unusually high number for a regional politician.

Rashid's popularity worries his regional opponents, who have termed him a "proxy" of Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).

Two former chief ministers of the state and the heirs of leading regional parties, Mehbooba Mufti and Omar Abdullah, have publicly questioned his party's funding and alleged that he was dividing voters to favour the BJP.

He has repeatedly denied the allegations. "If I were a BJP man, I wouldn't have spent over five years in jail," he told the BBC. "I won [almost] 500,000 votes in the general elections, how could I be dividing votes?".

Prof Sheikh Showkat Hussain, a political analyst, said Rashid's release from jail just days before the elections did give his opponents a pretext to accuse him of collusion with the BJP-run federal government in Delhi.

"Despite these allegations, his win in the 2024 parliamentary elections from jail has given him an unprecedented credibility in the eyes of the locals," he said.

Rashid has also worked hard to carefully craft his image.

Unlike the valley's prominent leaders who have established political lineages, Rashid has managed to establish an image of a "common man's politician" who doesn't shy away from taking on authorities.

the state secretariat as a protest against the government's inaction on the growing canine menace in his constituency, where numerous dog bite incidents had been reported.

"I hope the ministers and bureaucracy now understand the seriousness of the issue," he said at the time.

But Rashid's bluntness and candour have also landed him in trouble.

In 2015, he hosted a "beef party" to protest a ban on the slaughter of cows, considered sacred by many Hindus, in several states. A day later, members of the BJP, then a part of the state's ruling coalition, assaulted him in the assembly.

A few days later, members of a Hindu group outraged by the "beef party" attacked him at Delhi's Press Club, dousing his face with ink as he protested the lynching of a Kashmiri truck driver accused



of cow smuggling in Jammu.

Rashid's unusual protests have often addressed the alleged human rights violations in the Kashmir valley, a charge that the federal government denies.

On International Human Rights Day in 2015, his party marched through Srinagar with a cow, a mule, a goat, and a dog, holding placards saying, "Animals have more rights than people in Kashmir." He and other leaders were detained.

His family members say they are not surprised by his politics as he had a "rebellious nature" since childhood.

"He used to protest against the human rights violations, presence of military bunkers, forced labour by the army," said his brother Khurshid Ahmad Sheikh.

In 2008, he resigned from his government job as an engineer to contest assembly elections, winning twice in a row as an independent candidate.

Once elected to the state assembly, he gained recognition across Kashmir for protesting against what he called the government's "anti-people" policies, analysts say.

"The element of protest makes him popular. He has been a crowd-puller since he entered politics," said Noor Mohammad Baba, a political analyst based in Kashmir.

His jail term has intensified public interest in his rallies, he added.

At a recent rally, an enthusiastic group of men assembled to listen to him. Some of them were curious onlookers hoping to see the man in the news, and some were his fans.

Did the allegations of Rashid being a "proxy of Delhi" bother them?

"Almost all the regional parties have been in an alliance with the BJP [in the past]. They aren't in a position to allege him of complicity with the BJP," said Rafiq Ahmad, a businessman. "People want to give Rashid a chance and see what he does."

Rashid spoke and demanded a resolution to the Kashmir conflict and an end to the use of antiterror laws to put Kashmiris in jail. Young men shouted in unison in support.

Within minutes, Rashid was on his way to his next public meeting. BBC

India opposition leader resigns as Delhi's chief minister

Prominent opposition leader and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has resigned from his post, days after getting bail in a corruption case.

Kejriwal spent five months in jail in connection with a now-scrapped alcohol sales policy. He has denied the allegations against him.

He has said that he will take up the post only if people re-elect his Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) in the upcoming assembly elections.

Kejriwal's colleague and senior Delhi minister Atishi will replace him as the leader of the government, the party announced

AAP made its poll debut in 2013 Delhi assembly elections and has governed the capital city since, focusing on welfare measures such as affordable electricity and water for residents.

In 2020, the party won 62 seats in the 70-seat assembly – in almost a repeat of its performance in the previous election when it won 67 seats.

Kejriwal had announced his intention to resign over the weekend, saying he would sit on the chief minister's chair only if the people of Delhi gave him a "certificate of honesty".

"I got justice from the legal court, now I will get justice from the people's court," he told reporters.

Kejriwal has called for advancing the Delhi elections, which are scheduled for February next year, to November, aligning them with the upcoming polls in Maharashtra state.

Experts, however, say that is unlikely to happen.

Indian laws stipulate that elections cannot be scheduled less than six months before an assembly term's end unless the assembly is dissolved early. Additionally, the Election Commission considers factors like weather, festivals, and electoral roll revisions before announcing elections.

Arvind Kejriwal: The maverick leader who took on India's Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), which is the AAP's main opposition in Delhi, has called Kejriwal's resignation a "publicity stunt" to galvanise public sympathy.

An anti-corruption crusader, Kejriwal was the third AAP leader to be arrested over alleged irregularities in the now-scrapped alcohol sales policy.

Manish Sisodia, a former deputy chief minister, and AAP leader Sanjay Singh were also arrested in the case. Sisodia was granted bail in August



after spending 17 months in jail and Singh wa released on bail in April.

The policy was introduced by AAP in 2021, saying it would curb black market sales, increase revenues and ensure even distribution of liquor licences.

It was withdrawn a few months later after Delhi's Lieutenant-Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena accused AAP of exploiting rules to benefit private liquor barons.

The AAP denies the charges and has accused the BJP of using investigating agencies to unjustly target opposition leaders, a charge it denies.

Who is Atishi?

At 43, Atishi has become the youngest and third woman to serve as chief minister of Delhi.

She currently holds important portfolios such as water, finance, power and education in Delhi's cabinet.

In the absence of senior AAP leaders, who were jailed until recently, she served as the face of the party and swiftly gained prominence as a powerful leader.

Born to professors with Marxist leanings, Atishi studied at Delhi University and went to the University of Oxford for her master's degree. After spending a few years in teaching at a school in southern India, she was involved with alternative farming and education reforms.

She joined AAP in 2013 and has significantly contributed to overhauling Delhi's public schools as an advisor to former Deputy Chief Minister Sisodia.

Riding on her reputation as an education reformer, she was elected to the Delhi assembly in 2020.

She had contested the 2019 parliamentary elections, but lost to former cricketer Gautam Gambhir.

Earlier this year, she made headlines after she went on an indefinite hunger strike to highlight Delhi's water crisis during its peak summer months.

The flu: A guide for parents

Influenza (also known as flu) is a contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses that infect the nose, throat, and lungs. Flu is different from a cold, and usually comes on suddenly. Each year flu viruses cause millions of illnesses, hundreds of thousands of hospital stays and thousands or tens of thousands of deaths in the United States.

Flu can be very dangerous for children. CDC estimates that since 2010, between 7,000 and 26,000 children younger than 5 years have been hospitalized each year in the United States because of influenza. The flu vaccine is safe and helps protect children from flu. What parents should know

How serious is flu?

While flu illness can vary from mild to severe, children often need medical care because of flu. Children younger than 5 years and children of any age with certain long-term health problems are at high risk of flu complications like pneumonia, bronchitis, sinus and ear infections. Some health problems that are known to make children more vulnerable to flu include asthma, diabetes and disorders of the brain or nervous system.

How does flu spread? kid on the bed with temperature Flu viruses are thought to spread mainly by droplets made when someone with flu coughs, sneezes or talks. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby. A person also can get flu by touching something that has flu virus on it and then touching their mouth, eyes, or nose.

What are flu symptoms? Flu symptoms can include fever, cough, sore throat, runny



or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, chills, feeling tired and sometimes vomiting and diarrhea (more common in children than adults). Some people with the flu will not have a fever.

Think safety in fall as weather changes

Think safety as you enjoy the cooler temperatures and vibrant colors: Safely warm up by the fire. Inspect your fireplace before lighting the first fire. One of the simple joys of autumn is warming up in front of a fireplace.

If you have a fireplace in your home, be sure to have it cleaned and inspected before lighting your first fire of the season. A buildup of soot and creosote can cause a chimney fire and a backup of dangerous carbon monoxide gas into your home. Keep the area around the fireplace clear and remove any hanging decorations on your mantle. Most importantly, keep a fire extinguisher nearby at all times.

Never leave burning candles unattended. While glowing candles make any environment feel cozier, remember to keep burning candles away from anything that could burn, such as curtains, bedding or books. Also, always extinguish a candle before going to bed or leaving the house. Never leave children or pets alone with a burning candle.

Watch for new roadway hazards. Going back to school brings traffic changes. School buses, students on bicycles and teen drivers are out on the roads.

Slow down and take extra care to look for children in school zones, near playgrounds and residential areas. Also, never pass a bus with flashing red lights on, or another vehicle stopped for a pedestrian.

Be alert for wildlife on roadways. Wildlife is on the move in the fall, so watch carefully for deer, turkeys and other critters crossing the road in front of your vehicle. They are most active from dusk through dawn.

Remember that some animals — deer in particular — frequently travel in groups. If you see one crossing, more are bound to follow.

Share the road with harvesting equipment. In rural areas, fall brings the harvest season with large farming equipment on the roads. Be alert for slow-moving vehicles, and give them plenty of space. This provides better visibility to you and the other driver. Remember that they may turn unexpectedly into fields or driveways. Just because you can see the equipment does not mean the other driver can see you.

Get the yard ready for winter.

You've enjoyed your beautiful lawn and garden all summer, but now is the time to prep it for a cold winter. Leaf blowers can be loud and blow more than just leaves, so wear eye and hearing protection to keep you safe from flying debris and preserve your hearing from the dangerous effects of repeated exposure to loud noises.

Use ladders safely.

Falling is one of the most common reasons for emergency department trips. If you plan to clean out your gutters, work as a team when using the ladder. Ladders can buckle or slip, so have someone else hold the ladder as you climb up and down.

Keep your body weight-centered over the ladder, and don't reach too far. It is better to move the ladder a few more times than fall.

Get your flu shot.

Protect yourself from influenza with a flu shot. The viruses found in the influenza vaccine are inactive, so you cannot get the flu from the vac-



After getting vaccinated, it takes about two weeks to develop antibodies to protect against influenza. That's why getting vaccinated early in the fall is recommended.

The vaccine usually is available in early to mid-



Vash Raj Chopra was an Indian film director and film producer

Yash Raj Chopra was an Indian film director and film producer who worked in Hindi cinema. The founding chairman of the film production and distribution company Yash Raj Films, Chopra was born on 27 September 1932 in Lahore, into a Punjabi Hindu Khatri family. His father was an accountant in the PWD division of the British Punjab administration. He was the youngest of eight children, the oldest of whom was almost 30 years his senior. The eminent film-maker BR Chopra is one of his brothers. Chopra was largely brought up in the Lahore house of his second brother, Baldev Raj Chopra, then a film journalist. Chopra lived in Jalandhar in 1945 to continue his education, where he studied at Doaba College and originally sought to pursue a career in engineering. He later moved to Ludhiana, after the Partition of India. His passion for film-making led him to travel to Bombay, where he initially worked as an assistant director to I. S. Johar, and then for his director-producer brother, B. R. Chopra. He made his directorial debut with Dhool Ka Phool in 1959, a melodrama about illegitimacy, and followed it with the social drama Dharmputra (1961). Chopra rose to prominence after directing the critically and commercially successful family drama Waqt (1965), which pioneered the concept of ensemble casts in Bollywood. In 1970, he founded his own production company, Yash Raj Films, whose first production was Daagh (1973), a successful melodrama about polygamy. His success continued in the seventies, with some of Indian cinema's most successful and iconic films, including the action-thriller Deewaar (1975), which established Amitabh Bachchan as a leading actor in Bollywood; the ensemble romantic drama Kabhi Kabhie (1976) and the ensemble drama Trishul (1978). Chopra collaborated with Sridevi in two of what has been considered to be his finest films; the romantic musical Chandni (1989), which became instrumental in ending the era of violent films in Bollywood and returning to musicals,



and the intergenerational musical romantic drama Lamhe (1991), considered by critics and Chopra himself to be his best work, but underperformed at the domestic box-office although brought profits overseas. After helming the critically panned Parampara (1993), Chopra directed the musical psychological thriller Darr (1993), the first of his films to star Shahrukh Khan. Chopra directed three more romantic films, all starring Khan; Dil To Pagal Hai (1997), Veer-Zaara (2004) and Jab Tak Hai Jaan (2012), before announcing his retirement from direction in 2012. He died of dengue fever during Jab Tak Hai Jaan's production in 2012. He was considered one of the best directors in Bollywood industry.


Chopra was the recipient of several awards, including 6 National Film Awards and 8 Filmfare Awards. He is considered among the best Indian filmmakers. For his contributions to film, the Government of India honoured him with the Dadasaheb Phalke Award in 2001, and the Padma Bhushan in 2005. British Academy of Film and Television Arts 2006 presented him with a lifetime membership, making him the first Indian to receive the honour.


In 1970, Chopra married Pamela Singh and together they have two sons Aditya Chopra and Uday Chopra, born in 1971 and 1973, respectively. Aditya Chopra is also a film director and

producer and holds the position of chairman and managing director of Yash Raj Films, while Uday is an assistant director turned actor who made his acting debut in 2000 in his brother's directorial, Mohabbatein. He is currently the Director - Yash Raj Films, CEO - YRF Entertainment.

On 13 October 2012, Chopra was diagnosed with dengue fever and was admitted to Lilavati Hospital in Bandra, Mumbai. On 21 October, Yash Chopra succumbed to death following multiple organ failure. He was 80 years of age. HYDRA continues demolition drive in Hyderabad

Hyderabad: Continuing the demolition drive, the Hyderabad Disaster Response and Asset Protection Agency (HYDRA) on Monday razed alleged unauthorised structures at a park in the Madhapur area.

HYDRA officials razed illegal structures of a sports academy at Kavuri Hills Park in Madhapur, the information technology cluster.

Kavuri Hills Association had lodged a complaint against the sports academy and acting on the complaint, HYDRA pulled down the structures. After completing the demolition, the officials put up the Kavuri Hills Park board.

The management of the sports academy claimed that the Kavuri Hills Association had given the place on lease to them for 25 years. It alleged that even before the completion of the lease period they were unfairly evicted.

HYDRA Commissioner A.V. Ranganath, however, said the demolition drive in Hyderabad was carried out as per the court order.

The recently created body carried out the demolition of unlawful constructions for a second consecutive day. On Sunday, it pulled down 16

sheds constructed for commercial operations within the Full Tank Level (FTL) and buffer zone of Kukatpally Lake/Nalla Cheruvu.

The agency had also demolished structures illegally built on government lands at Kistareddypet and Patelguda of Ameenpur Mandal in Sangareddy district.

According to officials, the action was aimed at restoring and protecting the integrity of water bodies and government lands.

The HYDRA demolition drive at Kukatpally, Hyderabad, reclaimed four acres of the lake. The total area of the lake is 27 acres but about seven acres in FTL and buffer zone were encroached. The officials claimed that the structures used for residential purposes were not demolished.

In Kistareddypet, encroachments were removed from government land. Three RCC structures



reclaim three acres.

The demolition drive was carried out with the participation of officials from the Revenue Department, Irrigation Department, and Town Planning Department, alongside the HYDRA team.

AIMIM may expand into rural areas of Telangana

Hyderabad: Hyderabad MP Asaduddin Owaisiled All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) is likely to contest elections in rural areas of Telangana.

The report quoted sources saying that AIMIM may contest from Karimnagar, Nizamabad, Sangareddy, Vikarabad, Adilabad, Nirmal, Khammam, and other areas in Telangana.


