CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Haunted Bridge and Bones Crossing A mini-obstacle course. Winner navigates the course in the shortest time with fewest errors.

Pumpkin Toss Riders toss gourds into baskets, each worth different points. Winners based on points and time.

Jousting Hook the most rings in the fastest time. Each rider gets two rounds. (10-11 only)

Bob for Apples Both horse and rider will bob for apples. Place based on which pair retrieves two apples fastest.

Witches Jumping Jack o'Lanterns A 4-jump (18" - 2') course. Riders execute 2 jumps, put on a witch's hat at end, turn around and jump both upon return. Winner based on time, clearing jumps, and keeping hat on (11-12 only).

Barrels, Blood, and Rats A course around barrels that requires riders to carry cups of "blood" without spilling.

Ghost Riders Riders trot to end, dismount, put on ghost costume and trot back to starting point.

Legless Horseman Equitation Walk/Trot and Walk/Trot/Canter
Judging based on a combination of riding with and without stirrups.
