Connection with Franciscan Ministries Inc. or the Franciscan Sisters of the Poor

1. How did you become acquainted with the Franciscan Ministries Inc. or Franciscan Sisters of the Poor?

I became familiar with Franciscan Ministries nearly 10 years ago during my time at Greater Cincinnati Behavioral Health Services (GCB) on the Supported Employment team, when I connected with Haircuts from the Heart for a number of clients on my caseload. As I transitioned to a leadership role at GCB, I frequently directed my staff to utilize these services for clients preparing for job interviews.

Years later, I would become familiar with Centennial Barn, as my then fiancé and I were planning our wedding reception. Working with Mayo Woody during the planning led to a great friendship and partnership, which in turn led to collaborations on a number of projects for the Barn through my photography company (Breighton & Basette Photography). Since then, I've been involved in a number of Centennial Barn fundraising and marketing events.

2. Please describe why you would like to serve on the Franciscan Ministries Board of Directors.

At the heart of my work over the past 15 years has been a desire to lift up my community and to provide avenues for growth and advancement. As a practitioner and leader in mental health and supported employment services, I have been able to lend my skills and expertise in a variety of ways, utilizing a macro approach to problem-solving while also understanding the challenges of the work on a micro level. I enjoy asking questions, delving into difficult problems collaboratively to find solutions and will approach my work with the Franciscan Ministries Board in the same vein.

This experience extends to my current role in social services and community engagement with Nehemiah Manufacturing, a company on the leading edge of second chance employment and support services. My work with returning citizens experiencing significant barriers while employed (including housing, food insecurity, substance use, trauma, etc.) has been a true synergy of my skill set, and has further broadened my perspective on the challenges facing a largely underserved segment of our community. I would look forward to bringing this perspective to the Board.

Additionally, the connections I have made across many social service and community organizations are ones I believe could be leveraged for the benefit of Franciscan Ministries' mission.

But most importantly, in any situation, I have always endeavored to ensure that those who are routinely marginalized are given not just attention, but a voice. This, in my opinion, is critical in any organization that has as its aim the amelioration of social ills. I've seen firsthand the amazing work that Franciscan Ministries does on a daily basis, and look forward to being a part of furthering the mission going forward.
